WDCA President Out Over Radius – *From the Gazette (by Clem Pitt):* “Well known Warragul District cricket administrator Charlie Pierrehumbert has resigned all senior and junior positions in the Warragul and District Cricket Association. His resignation as President was accepted with regret by delegates at a meeting last Monday night. It is understood Mr. Pierrehumbert was deeply upset by the introduction of the experimental open radius rule at a recent special meeting. Mr. Pierrehumbert was strongly opposed to open radius and actively said so each time the matter has been raised. It was beaten by two votes at the Annual Meeting when new clubs Darnum and Warragul Centrals were not represented, and with those two clubs present, was carried by a two-thirds majority at the subsequent special meeting. Mr. Pierrehumbert has had a lifelong interest in the WDCA and Buln Buln Cricket Club. He has given strong support to junior cricket and is a regional team selector and team manager.

Surprise: Surprise new WDCA President is a second-year player in the competition, Mr. Ken Wragg. Mr. Wragg – married – is with a Warragul computer firm and has been a livewire in getting the new Warragul Centrals club formed. He has a sound knowledge of meeting procedure and was the only nomination to succeed Mr. Pierrehumbert at Monday night’s meeting.

Clearance: The WDCA has granted its first interclub clearance for nearly five years. Grant Walker has been given permission to transfer from Western Park to new club Darnum, where he will also play football with Nilma-Darnum Dusties.”

Streakers Rile WDCA Executive – *From the Gazette:* “Two streakers may have outed the WDCA Knockout Competition as an Association fundraiser next season. WDCA secretary John Kane said the incident reflected poorly on the two men concerned and did nothing for Association image. Their respective clubs will be requested to investigate the incident and take appropriate action. During the knock-out final – won by Buln against Jindivick on Sunday – two men wearing only happy smiles, skipped hand-in-hand out to the pitch and back again. The WDCA executive at a meeting on Monday night, said some other fundraising event may be introduced next season as a curb against this behaviour. The Association will solicit donations for the Rubina Ratcliffe Appeal at all grand finals, and clubs are asked to make individual donations as well. Other items discussed included the introduction of a team grading sub-committee, each club to compile their own batting and bowling averages, and a new Charlie Pierrehumbert Trophy to be incorporated this season in juniors.”

President's Report (by Alan Ross – from Western Park CC Annual Report)

“I have much pleasure in presenting the 6th Annual Report of the Western Park Cricket Club. This Annual Report covers both the club's performance on and off the sporting field for the past season (1985/86) and I hope that you will find this information interesting. Any criticisms that are made by myself or the four senior captains are meant to be constructive and I urge all of you to study these comments and assess their value to you as an individual player and more importantly as a TEAM MEMBER. The number of people who have the initiative and the interest to attend an Annual Meeting will indicate to me as President, and the other committee members, the level of participation we can expect from the members of the club. In other words, if we have the same old faces attending this Annual Meeting and then again taking on the bulk of the responsibility – as has happened for a long time now – this Club will never progress beyond being just an ordinary one which will never have teams consistently in the four and will not attract its share of above average players.

The 198/86 season was a big disappointment for the club both financially and on the field. The only satisfying part of the season was the successful introduction of our D-Grade side. The side performed creditably well and looks certain to succeed. Congratulations to all concerned. At the close of the 1984/85 season after narrowly missing out on finals (A-Grade), great expectations were held for the coming season, but this was not so. After losing last year's Captain-Coach only weeks before the start of the season, things looked dismal. This trend continued. A-Grade only managed to win one game, with C and D-Grade faring a little better. This certainly leaves room for improvement.

Congratulations must be given to Michael Jostlear who took on the position of Captain and after losing several players to injury, work, etc., things looked grim, but Michael stuck with it and although losing many games the side performed creditably well. Congratulations Mike.

Financially this year was a disaster. We finished the year with a deficit balance in the bank, something that is totally unacceptable with a Club of our nature and size. Little was done in the way of fundraising, however when functions were organised, they were not totally supported. We have only ourselves to blame. Certain changes need to be made at the club, new policies adopted, and a tighter control of the reins required. Let's aim for brighter things on the coming seasons...In conclusion I would like to thank all office bearers for a job well done. Thanks to all captains for their fine leadership and sportsmanship and special thanks to Peter Croft for his valued time and effort in coaching our Juniors. The direction in which Western Park will take for the coming season will depend on each individual. If Western Park is to succeed it is going to take a special effort by each and everyone. Will you be making the effort?"

A-Grade Captain's Report (by Mick Jostlear – from Western Park CC Annual Report)

"The start of the season the Club was in turmoil after the last year's Captain-Coach resigned two weeks before the first game. Over 22 players were given the chance to play A-Grade cricket. This season a lot of players showed great promise. Games we should have won were Ellinbank – twice – Warragul (washed out), Garfield-Bunyip (one-day game). Our only win for the season was Neerim District.

A lot of players have been around Western Park for a long time and it is time these players showed some improvement in their game of cricket to improve the strength of the club. Through practice and determination, players should be able to improve if the desire is there. If players next season in the club do not show this desire they should be played at a lower level, or not picked at all. The only way Western Park will improve is in discipline on and off the ground. Players to show improvement this season were Simon Byrne and Howard Cropley.

Our general fielding was of good standard and showed opposing stronger sides what we are really capable of. Our catching was poor on some days and excellent on others, which shows lack of concentration on these particular days. Due to many late nights for a lot of players on Friday nights does not help the situation. Batting showed our weaknesses with only two players scoring over two hundred runs – D. Holl and M. Jostlear. Our batsmen should put more emphasis towards the protection of their wicket. Bowling was strong and bowlers to improve were Simon Byrne, Peter Croft, Stephen Jostlear, and Mark Trewella. No batsmen in WDCA made 100 runs against our bowlers this year and a lot of sides would have been dismissed a lot quicker if catches were taken. I must especially thank Doug Holl as Vice-Captain for his help this season as being captain was new to me which I enjoyed most of the time. Let's see a big effort from all players in season 1986/87."

Club Champion – *by Doug Holl*: "The club this season initiated a perpetual trophy to be presented to the player who scored the most points based on batting, bowling, and fielding. The inaugural winner (and deservedly so) was A-Grade Captain Mick Jostlear. Mick took on the captaincy of the side under difficult circumstances and despite some ordinary performances by the side he continued to perform well with bat and ball. Congratulations on a fine season Mick!"

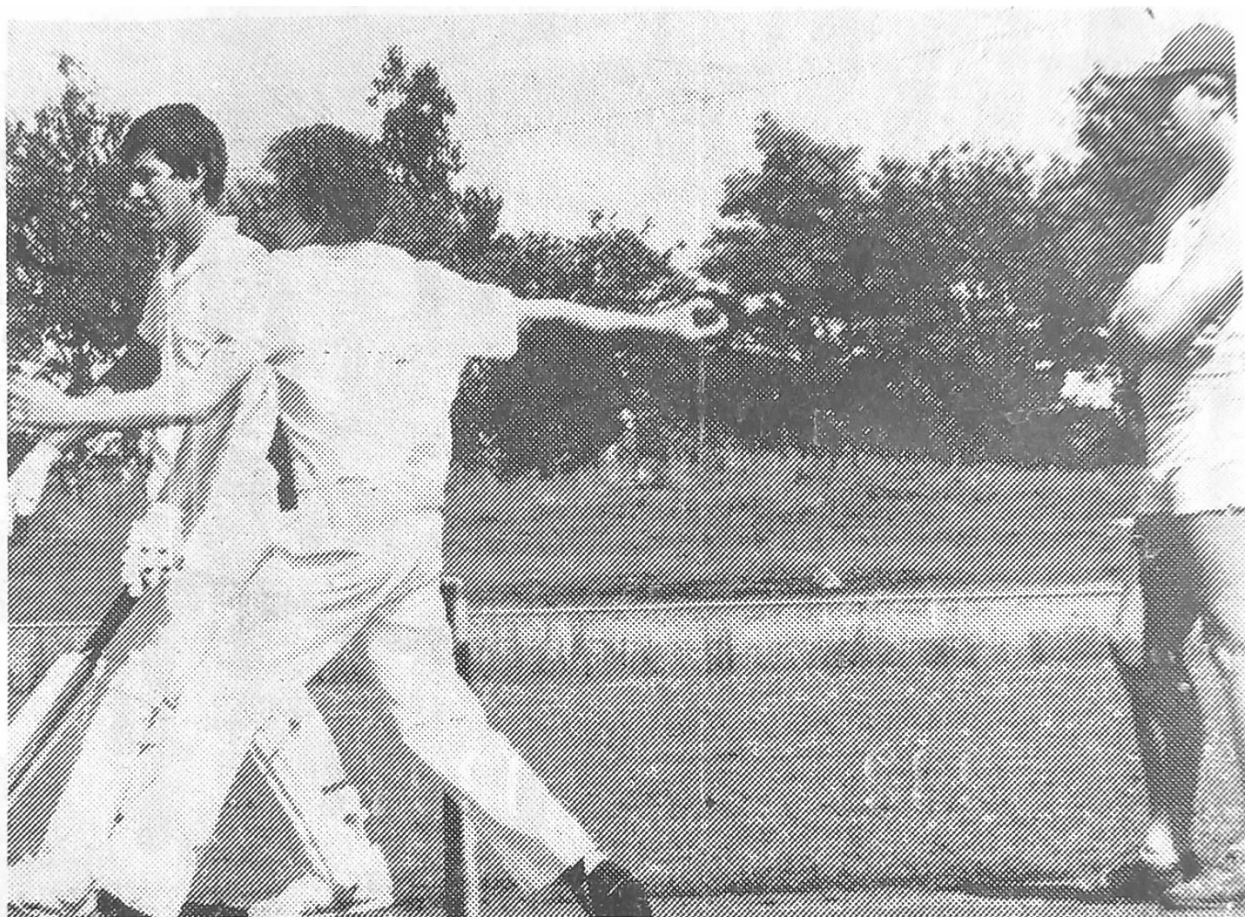
