WDCA Meeting – From the Trader: “The Warragul and District Cricket Association held its Annual General Meeting last Monday night. No nominations were forthcoming for that of President or Secretary, and at that point a motion came from the floor that the WDCA should disband. That motion was put to a vote and lost. A further motion that the meeting be adjourned until Monday August 21st, was carried... The most acceptable and viable suggestion however was that the WDCA appoint a paid administrator to act as Secretary-Manager and possibly Score Recorder as well. No doubt the rescheduled AGM on August 21st will answer a lot of questions. Administration is becoming a problem in most sports these days because many people who used to do jobs around their particular clubs and associations just don't have the spare time they used to.”

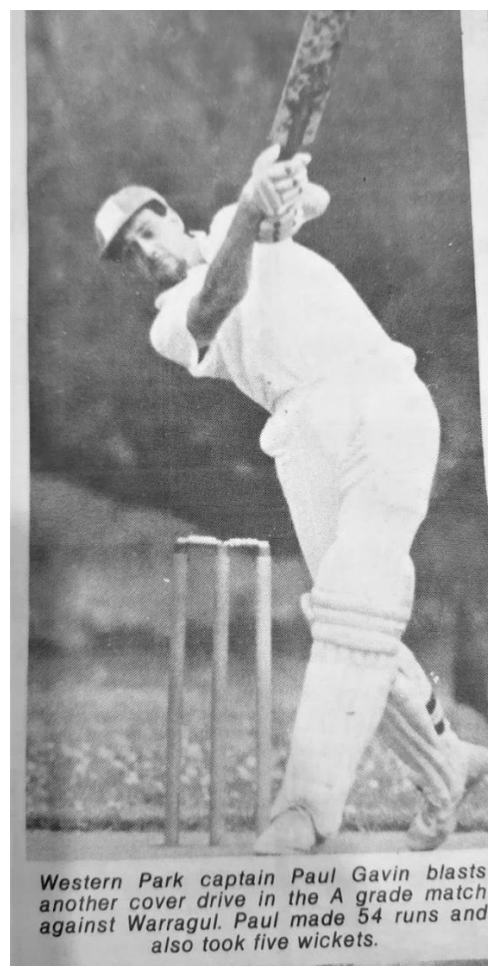
WDCA Report – From the Trader: “The WDCA has also decided to accept the Zone 10 recommendation to adopt the new ‘no-ball’ rule at senior level but not at junior level. The new rule reads as follows: A penalty of two runs shall apply **in addition** to any other runs scored from a no-ball. An explanatory note is as follows: The ACB has adopted a new experimental law which provides the penalty of two runs for a no-ball irrespective of whether the batsman scores from the ball or runs are scored in the form of byes or leg-byes... As a clarification, the new rule applies to no-balls but not to wides. No-ball are bowler infringements at delivery, three fielders behind square leg, and a bowler being called for throwing.”

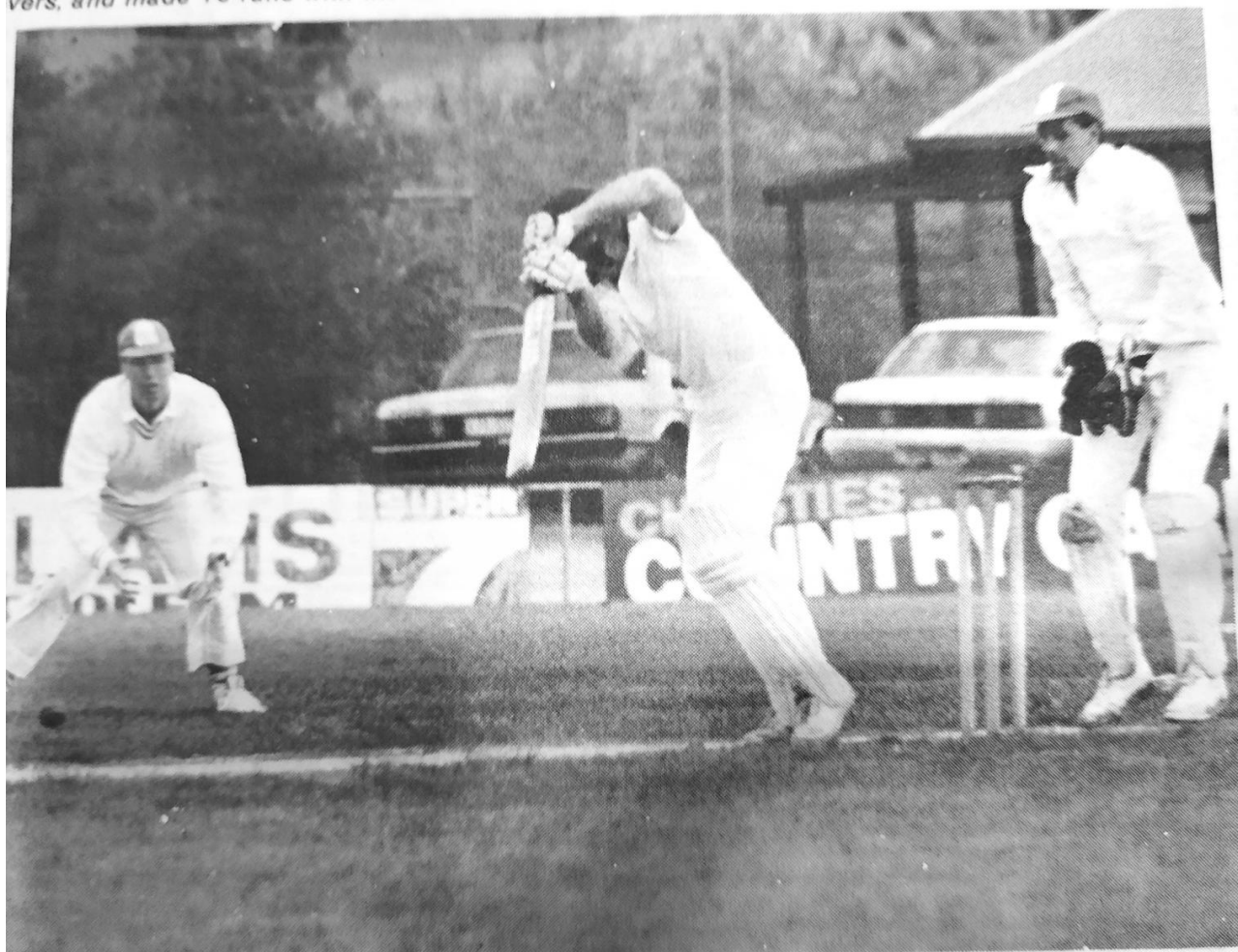

The home side had to bat for about an hour and a half and managed to reach 21 before stumps were drawn. However, the going wasn’t easy for the batting side as it took them nineteen overs to reach 1/21. The wicket was taken by Tony Kleeven who had Rod Cameron snapped up by Nick Mazza at gully. It was a sharp catch and well taken. Yarragon will have a big task ahead of them if they are to save this game next week, but they could do it with a bit of hard work.”

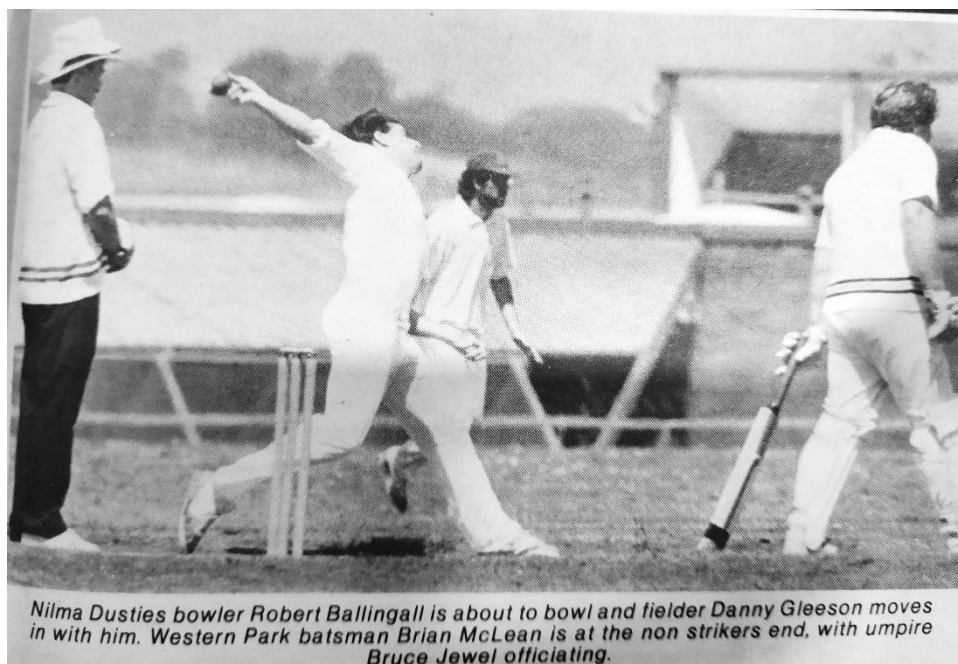

From the Gazette (by Peter Gallasch): “Western Park pulled off the first outright win of the season when they completely outclassed the young Buln combination. 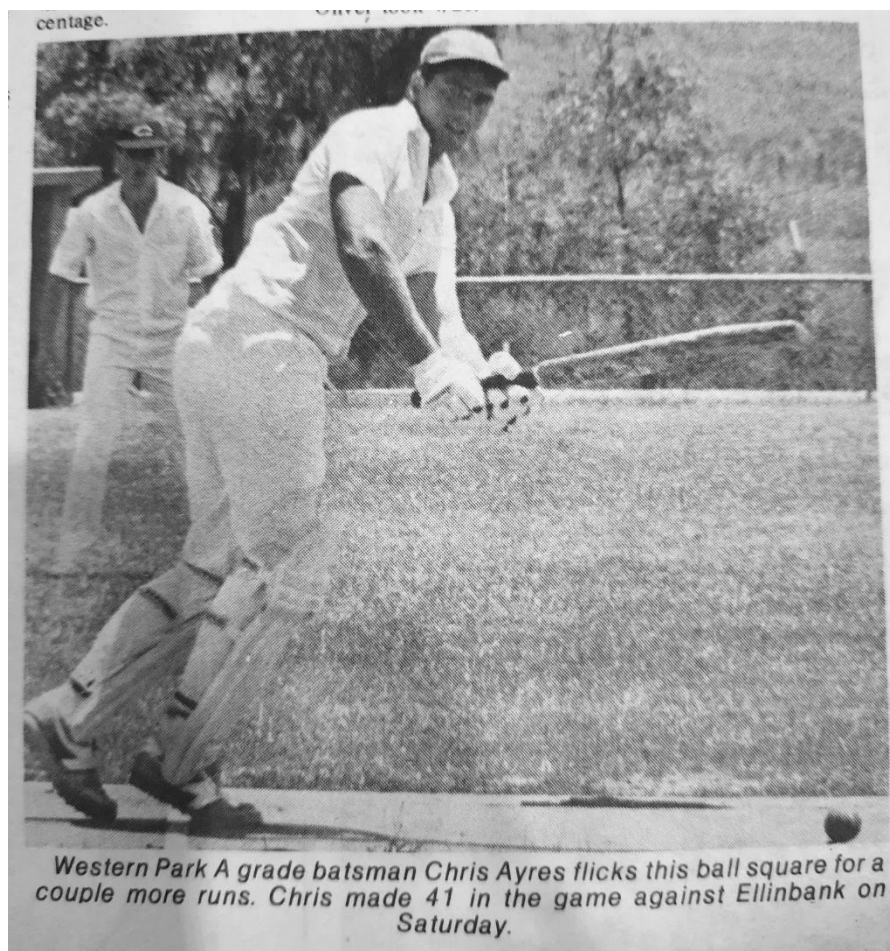

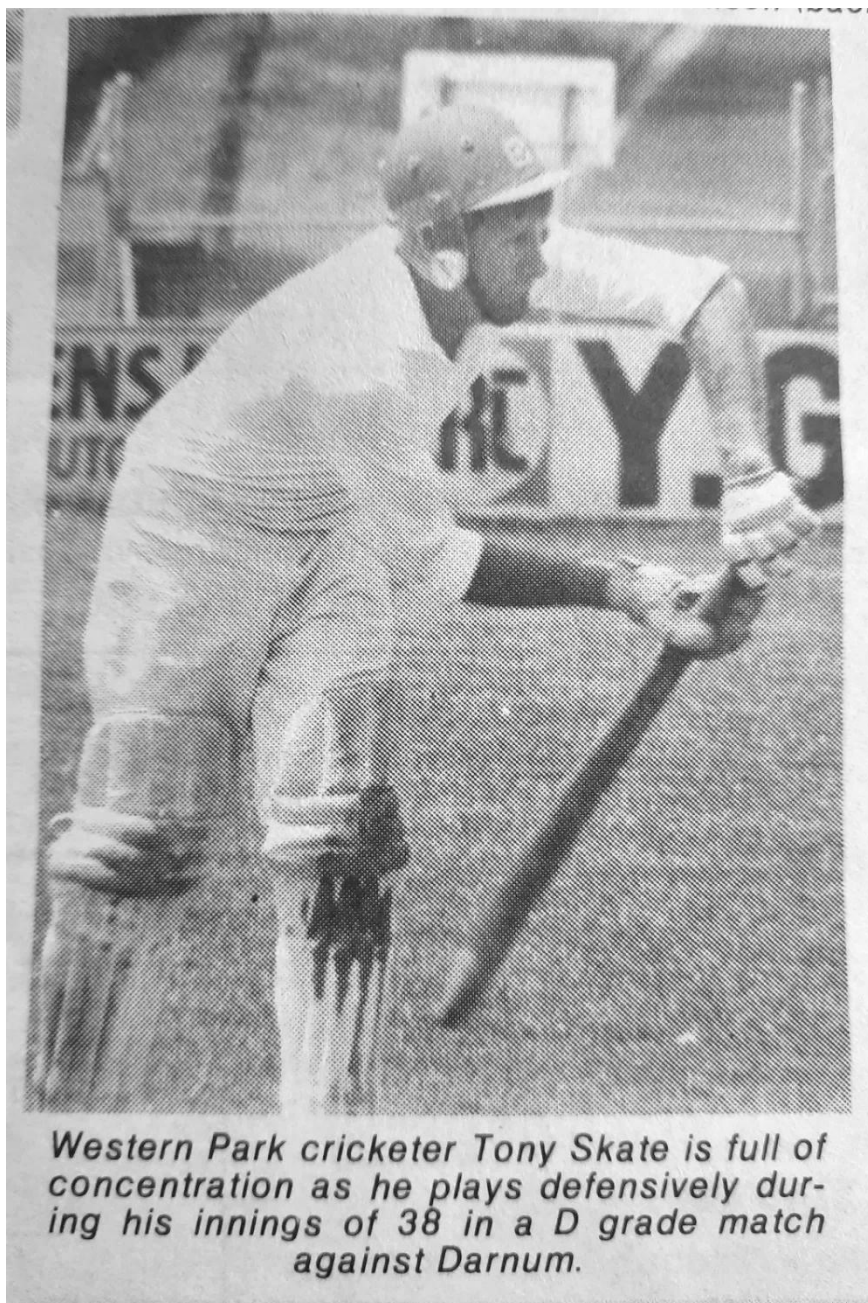

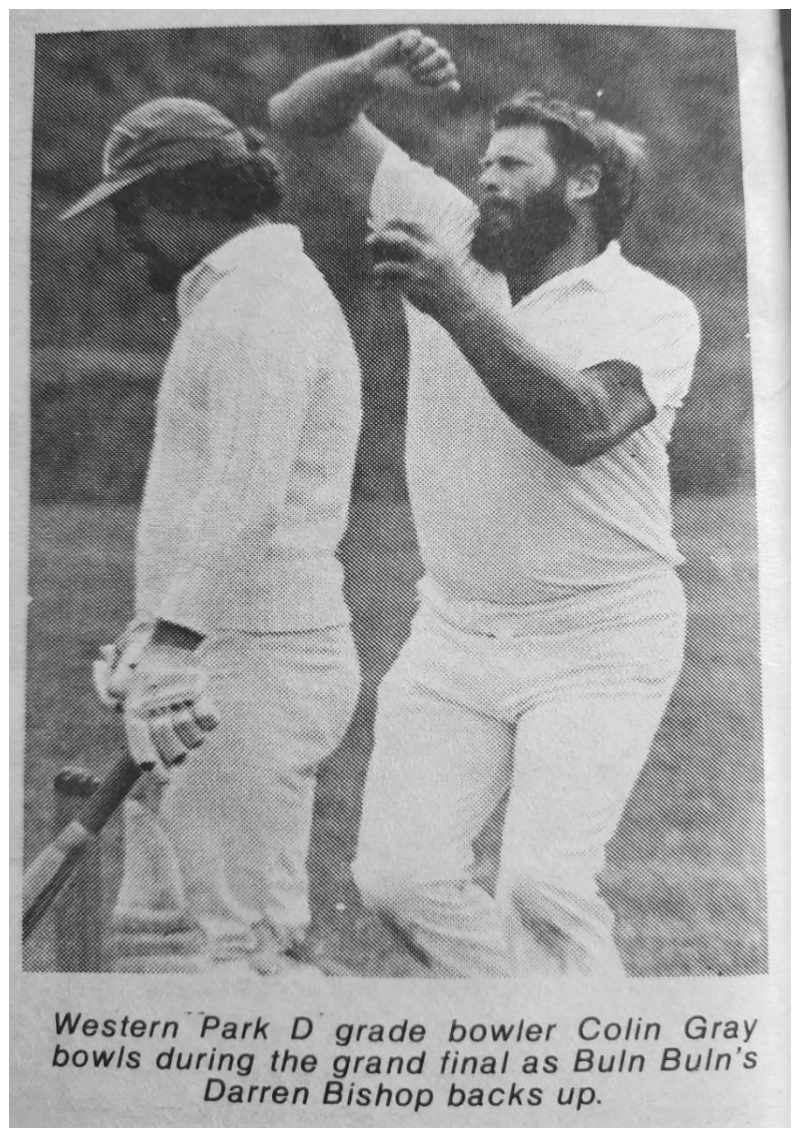

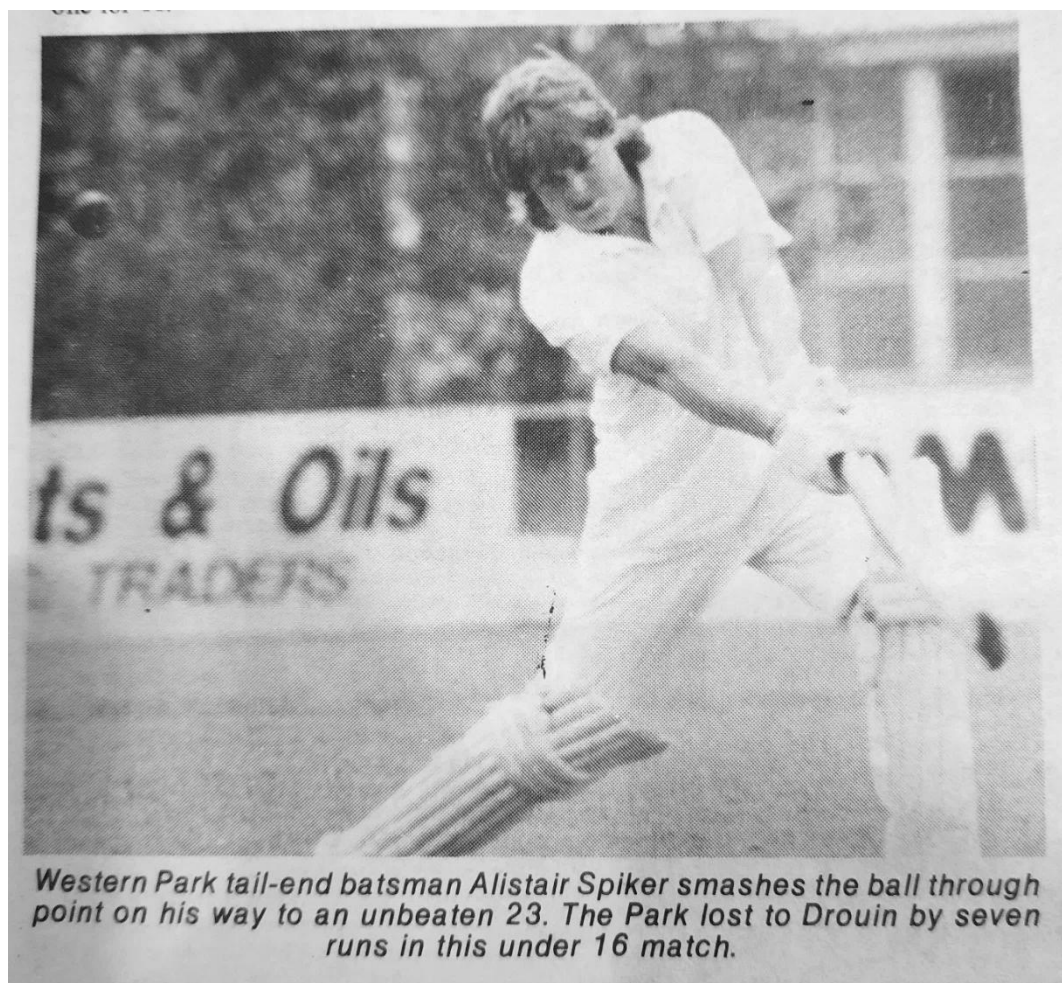
