Off-Season News

Action Man Will Pep Up The WDCA – *From the Gazette (by Clem Pitt, 6th September)*: “Western Park all-rounder John Kane is the new secretary of the Warragul and District Cricket Association. He is an ideas man not frightened to work, who should sharpen up several aspects of WDCA administration. It was noticeable from his comments at the annual meeting at Western Park last Thursday night that he means business. Mr. Kane is also acting scores recorder and he has been promised full support of the Gazette sports department in updating scores and scores services. Mr. Kane succeeds Mr. Carlo Bortignon, secretary for the past two seasons.

Each club will be represented for the first time – even those with only one team – on the executive. To act as delegates on this executive are Messrs C. Pierrehumbert, G. Davies, G. Shaw, K. Pitt, L. Coster, J. Fusinato, R. Prowse, J. Sinnett, R. Baldry, R. Gaff, and S. Giles in addition to Mr. J. Phillips (President), Mr. Kane, and Mr. Anthony Gleeson (Treasurer). It will be a club responsibility to see that its delegate attends executive meetings. Association selectors are Messrs J. Kane, R. Baldry, J. Sinnett, R. Ballingall and M. Gargan. Adverse weather contact is Mr. G. Johns (Trafalgar). Zone 10 Selector is Mr. J. Phillips and he and Mr. Pierrehumbert are Gippsland Cricket League delegates. A series of notice of motions were carried, the most important being the extension of A-Grade playing hours from 12.30pm to 5.30pm, instead of 5pm. A move to change the 1st vs. 3rd and 2nd vs. 4th finals system to 1st vs 4th and 2nd vs 3rd was narrowly defeated.”

New Awards For Local Cricket – *From the Gazette*: “Any cricketer missing out on a vote in Warragul and District cricket this summer will be very unlucky. There will be plenty around to be won. The Saunders Award is on again with six votes to be allotted to players in all grades. These are awarded by opposing captains. Umpires will also be asked to award 3-2-1 votes for a new A-Grade Best & Fairest award being sponsored by Moe Credit Union. The winner will receive a \$500 travelling voucher. A similar award will apply to B-Grade. Sponsor is King’s Chainsaws and Mowers. The winner will receive equipment valued at \$300. Enterprising WDCA secretary Mr. John Kane has organised these two new awards, which will be very much appreciated by players. Perhaps further sponsors can be found for the other three grades to have similar awards.”

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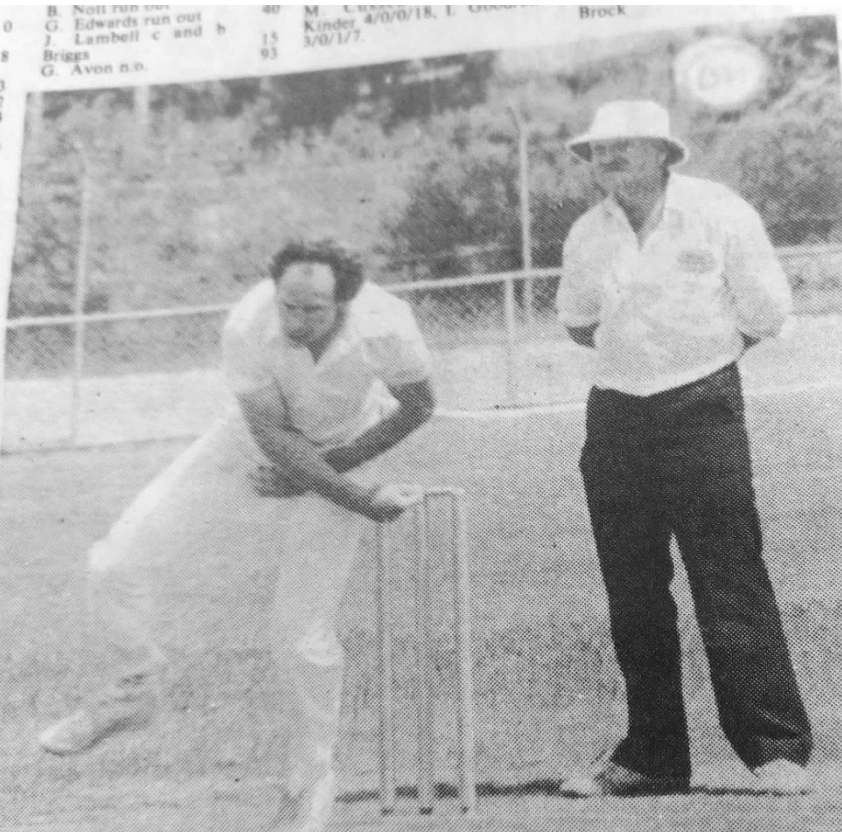

Nilma Dusties Crash For 43 – *From the Gazette (by Clem Pitt):* “Runaway WDCA A-Grade leaders Nilma Dusties were dismissed for 43 on a damp Western Park wicket on Saturday. Western Park already leads clearly on the first innings in a desperate bid to make the four after being written off at Christmas. Nilma Dusties captain-coach Michael Vick blasted his batsmen for their poor attitude to adverse batting conditions. Two were run-out, two fell to full tosses, and a couple of others to deliveries that went straight through. Vick – who played a couple of VCA District seasons with Collingwood – made 21 of his team’s 43.

At one stage, the hot favourites were 8/27. Three wickets fell at four, and three more at 20. It's the lowest score by a WDCA top side for years. No wonder Vick was upset with his side's display. The Western Park was watered by curator Royce Nuttall on Friday – maybe it was slightly over-watered as the roller became bogged at one stage. But all would have been reasonably well only for a five-minute thunderstorm that swept the ground at 8am on Saturday. Captains tossed knowing that the winner would be bowling. Luck was with Western Park. John Kane and Alan Ross sent down 20 overs to dismiss Nilma Dusties for virtually nothing. Both revelled on the moist track. Nilma Dusties hoped to roll Western Park just as cheaply, but a drying pitch and strong batting by Rod Weidermann foiled their plan. Unless there is further wet pitch worries next Saturday, the match seems certain to net Western Park first innings points."

WDCA Four Fight Odds With Drouin – *From the Gazette:* "Odds are with Drouin taking fourth place narrowly on percentage in the final WDCA A-Grade round starting next Saturday. President's Report (by Alan Ross – from Western Park CC Annual Report)

"I have much pleasure in presenting the 4th Annual Report of the Western Park Cricket Club for discussion and adoption at the Annual Meeting to be held on Monday 27th August 1984. This report will be circulated to all club members and supporters and as with last year's report will cover such areas as Captain's Reports, financial reports, and club records. I hope that you will find this report interesting and it will induce constructive comment so as to improve our Club's performance for the upcoming 1984/85 season.

The Club experienced mixed fortunes during the year, the highlight obviously being the success of our junior team in winning the Premiership and in doing so creating a new league record. As for our four senior teams none of them were able to make the four, although the seniors missed out by the smallest of margins. The 1983/84 season saw the introduction of our D-Grade side and although they experience little success they can only look forward to better things. The move to introduce a new D-Grade side was somewhat of an experiment for the club as in previous years we were struggling to field three teams, especially during the holiday periods. Too often the work is left to the usual few.

In conclusion, I would like to thank all the office bearers for a job well done. Thanks to our past President Graeme Hogan for many years of fine service and leadership. I would like to congratulate all of the winning Junior Premiership side. Thanks to all captains for fine leadership and sportsmanship and thanks to Peter Croft and Rohan Glen for the extremely difficult task of controlling our juniors.

The future of the Western Park Club still looks to be a bright one considering the fact that the A-Grade side won four out of the last five games to just miss out on a finals berth. The experience of the older members of the Club combined with the youth and potential of the many younger members – along with a little more dedication and aspiration – should see a big year for Western Park in the 1984/85 season. With this in mind, please make this year your year and put our Club back on top where we once were."

A-Grade Captain's Report (by John Kane – from the Western Park CC Annual Report)

"At the completion of the 1983/84 season the A-Grade team finished fifth, being only one game out of the final four and having the second-best percentage overall. This was really an amazing year for the A-Grade team because we had won only one match out of six up to Christmas and then won four out of five after Christmas. It is easy to speculate on what might have been if we made it to the finals, however, the players which made up our team in the latter part of the season were a very good combination which would have kept on winning if given the opportunity to play during March! Whilst I openly commented that the first half of the season was probably the most frustrating that I have experienced for a long time (because of the narrow losses), the second half of the season was magnificent and I congratulate all of those who contributed to this success.

Doug Holl, Peter Ross, Alan Ross, and Perer Croft were always consistent performers during the year and Doug winning the WDCA Batting Average was a just reward for his outstanding expertise. Alan Ross won the bowling average and is finally showing some consistent form and will be a very good cricketer in the near future.

I congratulate Royce Nuttall and all of the team who assisted him in the preparation of the turf wicket throughout the season and I have no complaints in this regard at all. We still have too quiet all of the experts (mainly from outside the club) who think they know all about the intricacies of the wicket preparation, however, Donald Bradman and Rodney Marsh were also told by the experts that they wouldn't make it either! So well done again, Royce, and you certainly have my full confidence.

One of the long-lasting impressions that I have from this past season was the excellent team spirit, which was clearly evident from the first game and, in my opinion, was the one factor which contributed significantly to our improved performance compared to last season. Individual efforts in a team game can effect some aspects of the game, but it is the team backing-up and general encouragement given when 'things get tough' which sway a game and we improved this aspect of our game to great benefit. As in previous years, the bowling department did the job very well and the batting, overall, was pathetic. Doug Holl's average of 66.8 stands out like a beacon, but the rest of the statistics should cause most of the players some embarrassment and disappointment and this aspect of the game (probably in all grades) needs immediate attention.

The whole club should be proud of the way in which the A-Grade team conducted itself on the field and I do believe that the younger players are progressing to the stage where they will be consistent contributors over a full season. It seems to me that any amount of coaching from anyone – other than a very competent coach – will not improve a player's technique or attitude to his game. I believe that in this region and most other country regions, you need to motivate yourself and learn to improve your game through self-motivation and studying other competent cricketers around you and then ask questions. This development appears to be evident amongst the A-Grade players in our club and I simply do not accept the comment that some players are not consistent because of a lack of coaching expertise.

In closing my report, I would comment that the past season was successful in almost every aspect of the game and the club should be encouraged by our results and I sincerely thank all of those players concerned. Finally, well done to the Juniors for winning yet another Grand Final and creating an Association record into the bargain."

D-Grade Captain's Report (by Brian Lemon from Western Park CC Annual Report)

With the start of the 1983/84 season, a fourth side entered in WDCA on the strength of a proposed strong recruiting program. The end result of the recruiting drive was a big ZERO, forcing the D-Grade team composition to be primarily made up of young inexperienced players. In 6 games up to the new year we could only field a maximum of four players aged 18 or over who had at least one year's experience in senior cricket. Such inexperience was the single factor for our early performances on the field. When we were able to add more experience to the side, we showed matches could be won against sides of similar standards. This season proved to be one of learning and gaining experience for the side.

The success of the side can be measured in areas other than the number of games won, it should be measured by the improvement of individuals and the team as a unit. Improvement did occur. Jeff Accardi turning in a fine effort as the number one strike bowler taking 32 wickets off 156.8 overs. In the previous season – his first – he was not a regular bowler of that side. [Also], David Purton and Brendan Waters earning promotion to the opening positions after starting off the season as middle-order batsmen. Both these players have shown excellent improvement in their batting technique and will further improve in the coming season. I feel the side has been a success. With more aggression in our game, I am confident the side can win a fair share of matches in the coming season.

I thank every player for their efforts during the season, and especially to my Vice-Captain – David Trewern – for his assistance both on and off the field. Good cricketing to every player in the future.”
