How it started

Western Park committee secretary Mr J. D. Johnson has provided background material in relation to the turf wicket controversy.

He details a special meeting at Western Park Pavilion on Thursday, September 20.

Subject was the continued existence and/or reconstruction of the Western Park turf cricket pitch.

Mr Johnson reports that Western Park Cricket Club president, Mr A. Ross addressed the meeting.

He reported that the club members considered themselves insufficient in knowledge and experience to professionally administer a turf wicket pitch.

Mr R. Nuttall, W.P.C.C. delegate explained the past efforts to maintain the turf pitch.

He considered two factors had contributed to the poor condition of the wicket at present - insufficient foundations and the amount of traffic the oval endured during football seasons.

Western Park Cricket Club expressed the desire to continue with present venue.

Following discussion, it was unanimously decided that the following motion be presented.

T. Topalovic/R. Howard moved "that the W.P.M.C. seek permission from the Shire of Warragul to remove the turf wicket, that a synthetic pitch be installed by the W.P.C.C. (with assistance from the Shire) as quickly as possible to ensure W.P.C.C. usage for the coming season."

Motion carried unanimously.

The overall condition of the oval was then discussed. It was felt major attention was needed in the area of drainage.

Moved M. Jostlear/T. Topalovic "that the W.P.M.C. secretary contact the Shire Secretary, Mr Bruce Davidson, to arrange a deputation to the next Parks and Gardens Meeting to present the above matters."

Motion carried and meeting closed 9.33 pm.

Western Park turf wicket

The following letter from Western Park Management committee secretary Mr J. D. Johnson has reached our sports desk, as follows:

Sir,
May I as secretary of the Western Park Management express my disappointment concerning Mr C. Pierrehumbert's statements as reported by you in the Warragul Gazette (Oct 16th) re the Western Park turf wicket.

The Western Park Management Committee meeting Mr Pierrehumbert attended on October 11th 1984 was the committee's annual meeting where office bearers are elected for the ensuing 12 months along with appropriate general business. The decision on the turf wicket being only part of that business.

I felt distressed that Mr Pierrehumbert took it upon himself to release a press statement concerning the turf wicket decision when he was only in an observer capacity at the meeting, and therefore not qualified to comment on official business that has to be conveyed to the Shire Council - of which the W.P.M.C. is responsible and answerable to.

A joint press release would have been made after the appropriate bodies had been informed. To actually make public and criticize those people who voted against the motion is a lack of discretion from a man who has and holds office himself on the W.D.C.C.

As the playing surface at Western Park has had a troubled existence since its inception I wish to make these points:

- Since 1978 when the complex at Western Park was officially opened approx. only 18 games of cricket have been conducted due to poor conditions or delays

- That both football clubs waited nearly 3 years before a full season could be conducted

- That the turf wicket has been reconstructed twice with Shire money and help

- That the Western Park Cricket Club requested the W.P.M.C. to remove the wicket so cricket could be played as soon as possible with a synthetic wicket installed

- That the two football clubs were not represented at the annual meeting when the re-affirmation of the earlier recommendation was cast, therefore no pressure was on the committee's re-affirming stand

- That as far back as June 1977 the Shire Curator reported to the W.P.M.C. of the problems of maintenance associated with a turf wicket

- That after early interest, labour and funds by the W.D.C.A. their assistance in later years has waned to the degree where the leaders of the current W.P.C.C. feel incapable of the struggle to realise an effective turf wicket

- That the W.P.M.C. has held many long and

careful discussions on the turf wicket issue and it is no comfort to the W.P.M.C. to finally surrender the ideal of a turf wicket at Western Park.

Therefore I regard Mr Pierrehumbert's actions that of someone who has emotionally found the decision unacceptable.

May I add that I cast my vote for the retention of the turf wicket, so consider my reply impartial to the issue.

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Turf is out at Western Park

Cr Albert Farrington's much quoted dream to see an international team play on turf at Western Park has ended in a nightmare.

The Merri Creek soil similar to that used on MCG turf wickets is to be pulled up and replaced by a synthetic pitch.

This means the proposed one-day match by Gippsland Zone 10 against the touring Sri Lankans next February will be taken away from Warragul and played at another Gippsland venue between Warragul and Bairnsdale.

Warragul has also lost staging of a Harvester Cup under 21 weekend match for the same reason.

Warragul and District Cricket Association president Mr Charlie Pierrehumbert claims the Western Park Committee of Management and the Warragul Shire has bowed to football pressure.

Victorian Country Cricket League Zone 10 representative Mr Barrie Wigglesworth is incensed claiming that money paid to develop Western Park's turf wicket has been wasted.

The death knell for Western Park turf sounded on Thursday night when the Western Park Committee of Management met again to consider a council request that the turf be retained until after the Sri Lankan visit, Mr Pierrehumbert attended as an observer.

After a 4-4 vote, the casting vote of chairman Mr Tom Malady confirmed the original motion on the grounds that if this request was acceded to, there would be insufficient time to prepare the oval for football next season.

The decision will go back to Council and acceptance is regarded as a formality.

And, that according to Mr Pierrehumbert, puts the WDCA need for a turf wicket back 15 years. It was he as secretary who first wrote to Council in 1969 requesting a ground be put aside as a turf wicket.

CHAMPIONS

"Warragul District, runners up to Geelong (hardly a country team) in Provincial Country Week and Gippsland Cricket League premiers are the undisputed champions of Victorian country cricket", he claimed yesterday.

"It's obvious Warragul Shire president Cr Pat Gogan and Cr Laurie Brown are not interested in our request as they both voted against the motion on Thursday night."

"There seems to be a feeling in Council that we

should go back to Logan Park's No 1 or No 2 ovals and put a turf wicket in there.

"But we left Logan Park to avoid clashing with the Warragul Show, greyhound and harness racing, pony clubs and dog shows".

"Logan Park No 2 oval, if fenced, could serve the purpose - the ideal situation would be a new oval specifically for cricket like Duncan Cameron Park at Traralgon.

"The WDCA comprises 57 teams with nearly 600 players - we are a big and highly respected competition.

"We are being asked to play second fiddle to football - fair enough. For the second time in 15 years I now ask Council - how about providing Warragul and District with a turf wicket oval in recognition of its top standing in Victorian country cricket?"

Council Favours Turf Wicket - *From the Trader (October 25th):* "Warragul Shire Council hopes that another turf wicket can be established in the town to replace one about to be removed from Western Park. The council on Tuesday night accepted a recommendation from the Western Park Management Committee that the wicket be removed immediately...Cr. Ian Clark said the turf wicket had been used as a scapegoat for problems at Western Park. The real problems were poor drainage and the ground had not been sloped properly. He believed a turf wicket could be established on the Logan Park No. 2 Oval. Cr. Laurie Brown said the Logan Park No. 1 Oval might be a more suitable site.... Merri Creek soil from the Western Park turf wicket would be stockpiled."

One Door Shuts...And Another Opens! - *From the Gazette:* "Western Park has lost the Sri Lankan cricket match...but it has gained the VFL country practice match between Hawthorn and St. Kilda in March. The Sri Lankans were to play a Zone 10 team at Western Park in February, stymied by a decision to pull up the turf wicket that is expected to be endorsed by Warragul Shire at a council meeting tonight on the recommendation of the Western Park Committee of Management. The management committee feels retaining the turf wicket until after the Sri Lankan match would reduce the time needed to prepare Western Park's playing surface for the next football season in 1985. A synthetic pitch will replace the turf if council endorsement goes ahead as expected tonight. Announcement that Western Park has been selected as a venue for the Hawthorn - St. Kilda match is therefore a bonus for Warragul and District."

WDCA Must Press On For Turf – *From the Gazette (by Clem Pitt, 6th November):* “It’s all over – that famous Merri Creek soil is being removed from the Western Park Oval and Warragul District cricket no longer has its first turf wicket. Does that mean (to quote WDCA president Mr. Charlie Pierrehumbert) that 15 years work has been wasted? Does it mean another 15 years wait before the WDCA - the undoubted strength of Gippsland cricket – gets back into turf cricket consideration? Considering that nearly every other Gippsland Association does have a turf wicket to make available to visiting international teams will Warragul District continue to lag behind them?

Considering that all Sale-Maffra competition pitches are turf and little areas like Lucknow have one – Warragul hasn’t – makes the situation almost laughable. Just how much the Merri Creek soil was to blame for Western Park being a football season pond is open to question. Perhaps it was the scapegoat for an unsatisfactory drainage system. Who cares? And what’s the point in discussing Western Park Oval any further? It’s a shut case as far as a turf wicket is concerned. Now, let’s get on with the game!

Constructively the WDCA must not weep crocodile tears and concede defeat on the turf wicket issue. It must go in harder now for an alternative venue. Warragul Shire Councillors have expressed an interest in developing Logan Park No. 1 or 2 ovals as a turf possibility. I feel like No. 2 is better because arena events like the Warragul Show could ruin turf on No.1. A fence around No. 2 Oval, a small but suitable pavilion, and a turf pitch could make this the Mecca of local cricket as it has shady willow trees on one side offering shade, and it's a fairly peaceful spot to play top cricket.

Cost of doing this could be around \$30 000 – not really large – but in the present climate of being pressed for an indoor sports centre to supplement the Arts Centre, any request of \$5 sends shivers up and down the spine of our civic fathers at the moment. I concede they have problems so why not the WDCA working out something to give them a financial hand in the interest of getting something done before the start of next season?

The WDCA has 57 teams comprising some 600 players. They are the able-bodied young men of the district capable of raising \$10 000 towards the cost of developing Logan Park No. 2 as their turf cricket headquarters and also doing a lot of voluntary work on buildings, fencing, and the turf. Advancing on Warragul Shire with a proposition to do their bit with cash and muscle on a dollar-for-dollar basis could see the project completed in time for the 1985-86 season.... So does the WDCA go back into its shell and forget turf wickets or does it come out fighting with constructive ideas? Charlie and Co – it's over to you!"

A-Grade Report (by Geoff Kneebone)

"At the beginning of the 1984/85 season, I had been with my previous club for a number of seasons and felt within myself that I could offer a little more to another club. I considered the proposition carefully and decided that with the youth and potential at the club a fantastic season would lie ahead. Well, this was not so.
