Pre-Season League News (from The Gazette 'Sports Shorts')

Western Park CC AGM: Mark Freeman was re-elected as President with life members Rod Breeden and Peter Croft being Secretary and Treasurer respectively...The enthusiastic gathering was delighted to welcome the return of Paul Gavin as Captain/Coach and further buoyed by the news that star fast bowler Paul Hughes has quashed rumours and assured the club he will be staying. An increase in player numbers is expected with some quality players expected to sign in the coming weeks. The club will nominate three senior sides and three junior teams for the upcoming season.

Development of the Turf – Western Park Turf Committee (Minutes of Meeting Held 15/8/2000)

“Present: Peter Croft, Rod Breeden, Mick Roberts, Paul Gavin, Shaun Litaize, Ritchie Parsonage (Management Committee), Bryan McLean, Matt Wakefield, John Laffy, Ian Clark (Shire), Andrew Lefebvre (Turf Wickets Victoria), Graeme Salmon (Melbourne Laser Levelling).

Apologies: Mark Freeman, Paul Hughes, Paul McCluskey, Rod Pollock, Jeff Tellefson.

Business Arising: “It was decided to go for the ‘Holy Plains’ soil from a Rosedale farm. Turf Wickets Victoria (TWV) was happy that the soil test results obtained by the Traralgon Cricket Association were OK. This soil would be cheaper than the Merri Creek soil from Melbourne as the farmer practically gives it away (in return for a slab or two sort of thing). We will need to organise the loading and freighting of the soil. This could all be done on the same day as the old pitch is excavated (approx. Feb 2001). Melbourne Laser Levelling would be present to level the existing base before the ‘Holy Plains’ soil is laid.

Ian Clark stressed the need to lobby the Shire Councillors regarding the grant. Ian will send Peter Croft a list of Councillors and they will be divided up between us to lobby. We also need letters of support from Western Park Management Committee (Ritchie Parsonage), WDCA, VCA, and TWV. If the project goes ahead, we will need home games to be scheduled away from the start of February 2001.”

Pre-Season Preview (From the Trader, by Mick Pratt)

“Welcome back to all cricketers and supporters of the WDCA for season 2000-01 in what looks like being another fabulous season of country cricket. It’s hard to believe that the season gets underway this Saturday. A lot has happened in the off-season with the main highlight being that Garfield is back up in the A-Grade competition. The WDCA looks as if it might weaken a bit due to the loss of players such as Geoff Van Vugt, James McMahon, Ben Ryan, Tim McMahon, and Leigh Baldry, but who knows this could create evenness between all teams in the A-Grade division. We will now take a look at the A-Grade competition to see how they are shaping for the upcoming season.

Neerim District: Reigning premiers, Neerim have seen Paul Gavin depart to Western Park after doing a superb job as Captain-Coach last year. This has made way for Rick Emery to jump into the coaching role. With no big-name recruits to date, Neerim will be aiming for back-to-back flags with basically an unchanged side. Dale Fawcett has also gone to the Parkers with Gavin in pursuit of another premiership. For Neerim to dominate proceedings again all of their remaining premiership players – and the ones who were unfortunate to miss out last year – have to make solid contributions to the team’s performance at different times throughout the year. These boys know how to win, and I think they will use this to their advantage and possibly have another memorable season. *Prediction:* Third to Sixth.

Drouin: Last year’s coach Ron Harper has stood down from the position and Steve Austen has taken over Ron’s spot. Steve is an exciting all-rounder, and he should fit into the coaching role smoothly. After finishing runners-up last season Drouin would be setting their standards to go one step further this year. Their only major pick-up to date is left-arm quick Mal Amey from Ellinbank. Mal will slot straight into the bowling line-up alongside Brad Aitken and Rick Minichiello. Drouin have the potential to go all the way this season. To do so they will have to perform more with the bat and not rely on their top three week in, week out. They will also require a bit of improvement in the bowling attack. *Prediction:* Top Two.

Warragul: Warragul has signed up Jeff Sinnett as non-playing coach for this season. Jeff is a stalwart for Warragul and if he is as successful as he was in his playing days then Warragul have a fairly good chance of having another top-quality year. They have recruited three young rising cricketers in Mick and Steve Tumino, and Aaron Rhodes – all of which previously played for Ellinbank.

With the losses of Leigh Baldry and Ben Ryan – who are going downtown to further their cricket careers – and the recent retirement of Ray Waters they might lack a bit of strength in their batting department. Youth is the big key for Warragul being a successful campaigner for season 2000-01. The older experienced cricketers have to get behind their young blokes. If this task is to be completed without any problems, then they will be featuring later on in the year when it comes to finals. *Prediction:* Third to Sixth.

Hallora: Last year's semi-finalists, Hallora has appointed Simon Phillips to the coaching role. After a dismal exit from the finals last year when they were chasing back-to-back flags, Hallora will be keen to make up for it this year. With the McMahon brothers departing from their line-up, it adds a slight degree of difficulty to their job for the approaching season. Whilst they are still waiting on a few top-class recruits Hallora could find it difficult to match it with Western Park and Drouin. Hallora will need to cover the losses of the McMahon brothers quite early in the season otherwise they will probably find themselves behind the eight-ball. Many teams have lost big-name players, and this would suit Hallora, which could see them taking part in the finals in March. *Prediction:* Third to Sixth.

Yarragon: Yarragon has reappointed last year's coach in the big-hitting John Allsop. After a disappointing end to last year's season with a loss to Buln in the final round – which cost them a finals berth – they will be out to make up for it this year. With the recruitments of Nathan Bright, ex-Buln paceman Matt Nelson, classy all-rounder, and the return of John Malacarne and Matt Brown it is possible for the Panthers to go a couple of steps further this season. For the Panthers to be a danger to the big-name sides they will need to record victories in the early stages of the season and see an improvement from their younger players such as Colin Bell, Phil Solohub, and Josh Mumford. With an impressive bowling line-up and a classy fielding side the Panthers will be hoping that their under-rated batting department steps up to make a few 300+ scores. *Prediction:* Third to Sixth.

Western Park: With the welcome return of Paul Gavin straight into the coaching position – after his success at Neerim District last year – makes way for a huge season. Last season would be one that the Parkers would want to put in the back of their mind. Gavin – a superb opening batsmen-wicketkeeper has also brought Dale Fawcett, his batting partner from last year's winning side with him. They have also picked up Warragul's Nick Marsh who is a young forceful middle-order batsman. If the Parkers are to play a big part when it comes to finals time, they will need to get behind their immensely talented coach and minimise their mistakes that occurred last season. They have a healthy batting line-up and probably the strongest bowling attack in the league. *Prediction:* Top Two.

Ellinbank: Veteran wicketkeeper-batsman Darryl Hardy has been signed as the 'Bankers' new coach after the retirement of last year's coach Geoff Van Vugt. The Bankers have also lost stalwart Peter Wallace through retirement, and speed bowler Mal Amey to Drouin, and the young Tumino brothers to Warragul. The recruitment of Col Smith – a nifty left-arm bowler from Drouin – and Glen Lineham (a splendid all-rounder from Catani), and Matthew Long the pro golfer. The Bankers will be praying that Matthew Long is just as good at cricket as he is at golf. Youth and enthusiasm will play a major part if they are going to battle with the big guns this season. Whilst they have a reasonable bowling line-up they will struggle to put the runs on the board. With the losses of Van Vugt, Amey, and the Tumino boys, I think it will be a season to forge for Ellinbank. *Prediction:* Seventh to Ninth.

Buln Buln: Last year's wooden spooners Buln have appointed Andrew Best to the coaching position for this season. Andrew comes with a lot of A-Grade experience from a previous stint at Warragul. He has also brought his brother Daniel along – who is a superb cricketer. Nathan Kenny is the only major loss to date. If Buln wish to make an impact this season they will have to get behind 'Besty' and see a substantial development with the younger players at the club. I believe that the elusive premiership that Buln wants to get their hands on is still a couple of years away. *Prediction:* Seventh to Ninth.

Garfield: After their inclusion back into the A-Grade ranks, Garfield signed up John Barrow as non-playing coach, who has ventured down from the Sale-Maffra league to provide Garfield with his talented abilities and strategies to hopefully bring them success. Matt Cunningham has returned to the club along with several other established cricketers from the West Gippsland, being Nick Bullock, Peter McGill, and Daniel Dal Santo. Last year's B-Grade premiership players will have to improve and also adjust to the style of A-Grade cricket early in the season if they want to go toe-to-toe with the benchmark sides. They are inexperienced – which could prove costly – and also their batting department could let them down as they only made 200+ on two occasions last season. With the new recruits Garfield should be able to notch up a few victories in their comeback to this level of cricket. *Prediction:* Seventh to Ninth.

Other Clubs

Bunyip: After finishing on top of the C-Grade ladder last season and failing to go any further Bunyip would be keen to make up for the unexpected exit this season. They have gone back up to B-Grade and will be a threat to most teams that step in their way. The Bulldogs are self-coached, but well-known strategist Travis McNamara heads them. Dale Pronk and Justin Stirling are two of their big recruits who have joined the club after leaving Narre Warren. The Bulldogs must learn to take their brilliant performances into the finals with them. They can't just stop when the home-and-away season finishes. The big key is that they have to not only win but also enjoy their cricket along the way. I believe that the Bulldogs could take a couple of flags home with them this season.

Iona: Iona has re-appointed Glen Johnson as senior coach for this season. After just missing out on the finals in B-Grade last year Iona might find themselves a little bit further down the ladder this season due to the losses of Brett Johnson – last season's Cricketer of the Year – and Danny McGennissen. Opening batsmen Daniel Tomasetti has returned and a couple of all-rounders in Ken Reeves and Sam Edwards have signed up for this season. Iona has a talented batting line-up and [are] an outstanding fielding side. Their bowling may cause them a few problems as they have no genuine opening bowlers. I think that if Iona wants to have a chance of competing in the finals, they will have to rely on making big scores every week.

Jindivick: Dave Marshall has returned to the club after his stint in Melbourne and he has taken on the senior coaching position. He has brought with him a couple of good batsmen, in the form of Shaun Doolan and George Zekic. Michael Kindermann from Boronia is another new face at Jindivick, and he should fit nicely into the batting line-up. John Rasmussen – former fiery right-arm bowler from Buln – has come out of retirement and should lead the bowling attack. Their only major losses are the Smart brothers Hayden and Matt. Jindivick look like they have a reasonable side and after just missing out on finals action last year I'm sure they will feature in them this season. Jindivick have to win all 50/50 games and play as a team and not depend on three or four blokes to win them the game. I think that Jindivick will be the surprise packet in B-Grade and could find themselves the team to beat.

Longwarry: The grand final in C-Grade last year will be the one to forget for Longwarry as the premiership was more or less theirs until Buln snatched it off them. The boys know that there is some unfinished business to complete this season and that's why they haven't picked up any key players, because they already have a rather strong side. Although they have picked up a number of players due to the inclusion of a one-day side, and who knows, some of them could turn out to be remarkable cricketers. If Longwarry is to go one step further this year, then the more experienced players will have to take the younger players under their belt. The Crows are a real chance for the flag this year if they stick together and show more consistency throughout the home-and-away season.

Nilma-Darnum Dusties: NDD have appointed John Hibbert and Rob Juratowich as co-coaches for this season. NDD have recruited well and signed up Steve Ward – a splendid leg-spinner who has crossed over from Warragul – Hayden Smart (who has made the journey from Jindivick) and Neil Olsson, a right-arm bowler from Buln. Jake Sharp, Greg Stephens, and James Hardie have all gone elsewhere. After sneaking into finals in B-Grade last year NDD will be out to make a bigger impact this year. They have a lot of depth and variety in the bowling attack, which will be the vital key if they are to perform well and if they can become more consistent with the bat and win the nail-biting games, they will certainly be around come finals time."

From the Trader (by Mick Pratt): "The Warragul and District Cricket Association finally made a start to the 2000-01 season on Saturday in near perfect conditions, after the first two rounds were incomplete due to inclement weather conditions...In A-Grade the 'match-of-the-round' between Western Park and last year's Grand Finalists Drouin is shaping up to have a fitting finale this week. Drama occurred before the first ball was bowled, as they had to move the match from Bellbird Park to Western Park due to the poor conditions of the ground.

The delayed start didn't seem to have any effect on Western Park as they managed to bat the whole day, registering a competitive score of 230. Peter Croft was the main scorer and made a classy knock of 44.

Other contributors were Matt Wakefield (37), Shaun Litaize (36), and Dale Fawcett (25). For Drouin, Jon Perry did most of the damage taking 3/49 off 9 overs. Whilst Rick Minichiello, Daniel Butler, and Steve Austen each took two wickets. If Drouin are able to see out all the overs next week, they should record their first victory of the season, although Western Park are more than capable of knocking them over for a cheap score."

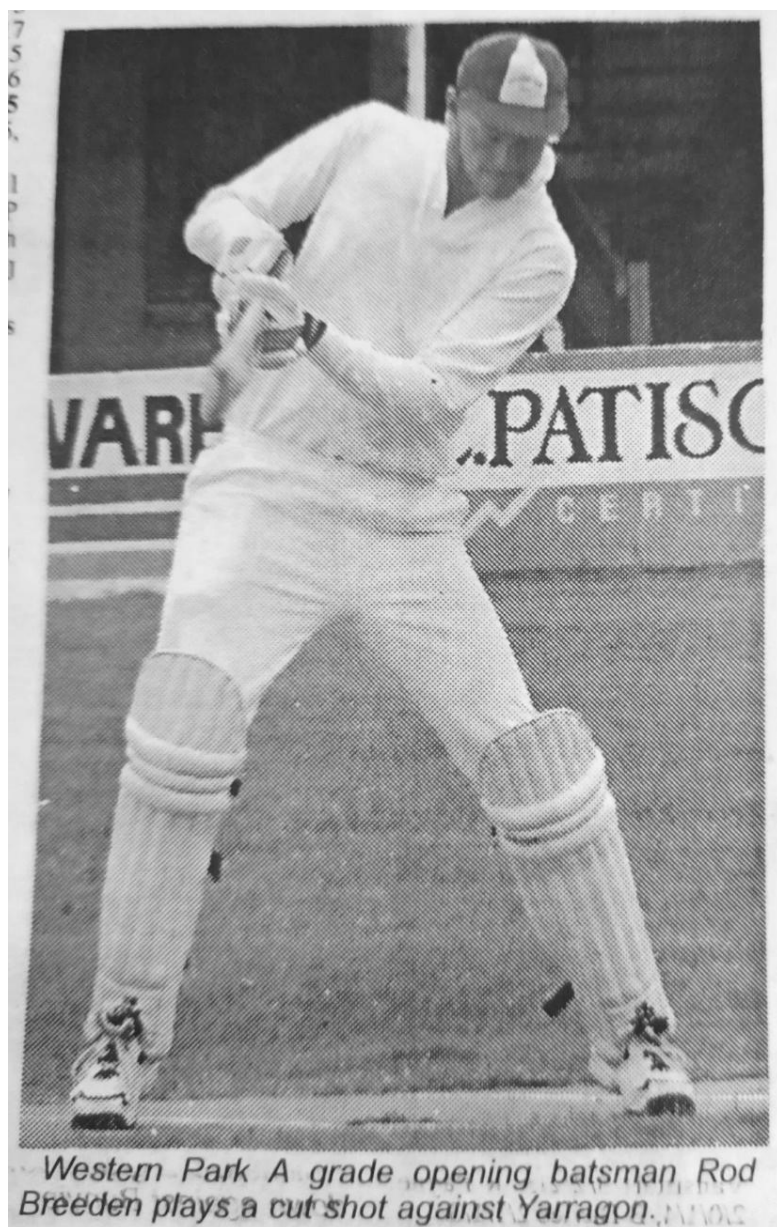

Community Assistance Grants

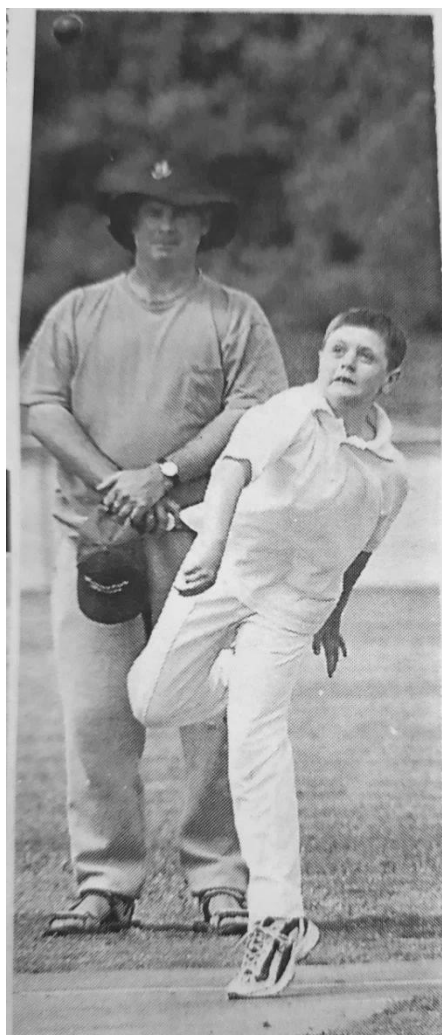
