Given that St Paul's will not be fielding a team and the concern that the re-scheduling of under 14 games from Sunday to Saturday might impact on the under 16 competition numbers, the Junior Executive is very pleased with the efforts of club officials to obtain players.

Although a couple of sides still need to bolster numbers, it is envisaged that there will be ten teams in under 12s, ten in under 14s and nine in under 16s.

Because of the uncertainty in recent weeks it has been decided to defer the formulation of a draw until confirmations are known.

To this end the Executive has prepared a round one draw for October 5 only (one day game).

A full draw will be prepared, circulated and published in the Gazette as soon as possible.

Wet weather results in crisis meeting

A crisis meeting has been called by the Warragul and District Cricket Association executive to determine if first round cricket will be played this weekend.

The lack of available grounds has caused the executive to re-assess the draw to determine what action it can take to allow this Saturday's first round to continue.

All clubs will be involved in tomorrow night's crisis meeting which will look at what options are available given the lack of grounds available for playing.

WDCA vice president Brian Sell said at this stage it did not look as if there were enough grounds for all teams to play on.

Mr Sell said 35 teams needed 17 grounds to play on this weekend and at this stage there was a possibility that seven of those grounds would be unavailable.

Mr Sell said the weather conditions and other individual club factors had meant some grounds were not in a playing condition.

He said some of the grounds had not been un-

covered while other grounds weren't up to scratch, one was under water and some hadn't laid pitches yet.

Mr Sell said there were 14 clubs involved in the association.

Of these clubs, Mr Sell said Longwarry and the St Paul's grounds were still covered, Hallora, Warragul Regional College and Iona hadn't laid pitches, Bunyip was unplayable and of the two Yarragon grounds one was under water and the other had been recently reseeded and it was impractical to play on given the current weather.

Mr Sell said the general feeling of the association

was to abandon this week's games and put the draw back a week.

He explained the association would have two options available to catch up on the missing week.

Teams will either be required to play round three as a one day game or rounds one and two will be played on a Saturday and Sunday.

He said all club presidents and secretaries should be represented at the crisis meeting so the association could determine what action to take.

The meeting will be held at the Buln Buln sporting club rooms tomorrow night at 7.30pm.

Round 1: Abandoned

Round one cricket abandoned

A CRISIS meeting called by the Warragul and District Cricket Association last night resolved to abandon this Saturday's cricket round.

After two hours of heated debate, the 35 clubs finally agreed to abandon the round one matches scheduled for this weekend because of a lack of available grounds.

Association vice president Brian Sell said the cricket season would now begin with round two on October 12.

He said no points would be allocated to any of the teams for round one.

Mr Sell said the decision not to reschedule the match

later in the season may affect team positions at the end of the season because of the bye in B grade.

The decision to abandon round one was carried 18 to 17.

A first motion to put round one back to January 4 during the free week over Christmas did not gain enough support.

Mr Sell said there was a possibility that seven grounds would still be unavailable next week.

"If any grounds are unavailable on the 12th, it will be classed as a draw game," he said.

From the Trader (by 'The Roving Warrior'): "Western Park A-Grade ventured to Drouin on Saturday, expecting a tough encounter, and weren't disappointed. Warriors skipper Paul Hughes won the toss, and his side got off to a cautious start – being 0/26 off 10 – due to some honest bowling and fielding from Drouin. Drouin's persistence paid off in the 15th over claiming the wicket of Gavin leg before for 29, Western Park 1/61. Litaize teamed up with Pollard to add a further 28 before Litaize lofted an on-drive wide of Trollope – who almost pulled off a screamer – then recovered to throw down the stumps at the non-strikers end. This cut short a fine innings of 51 from the fleet-footed Pollard. 2/89 and then 3/89 next ball, when Litaize was out to a sharp catch in gully.

With two new batsmen at the crease Drouin had a sniff but due to some intelligent batting from Croft (41 not out) – who featured in four separate 20-run partnerships with McLean, Ayres, Wakefield, and DeJong – the Warriors were able to set the Hawks a target of 169 for victory. The pick of Drouin’s bowlers were T. Davies (2/24) and A. Neumann (3/34).

Drouin’s run chase started slowly, being given few scoring opportunities from the Western Park bowlers. McLean picked up the first wicket in the eighth over with the score on 12, then Paul Wyatt and Trollope added 53 before Hodder snared Trollope for 21, Drouin 2/65 off 24. The Hawks were desperate for quick runs and turned to Davies, who swung hard from the outset, scattering the field, clearing the pickets a couple of times, and adding 39 from only a handful of balls faced. When Roberts struck with the wickets of Davies – and then Harper – Drouin required a run-a-ball off the last five overs. But Western Park’s bowlers, led by ‘Captain Grumpy’ Hughes were able to restrict their opponents to 7/151, despite a solid 56 from Drouin’s Paul Wyatt.”

Pollard and Litaize then got on with the job, with both players hitting the ball sweetly.

Unfortunately, Litaize edged one to the keeper when the score had reached 91. Croft then joined 'Whispering' John Pollard for what proved to be a record third-wicket stand for Western Park. The pair added 189 and when Croft fell for a solid 63, Pollard followed soon after for a marvellous 149, as good an innings as I've seen by anyone. Minor contributions by McLean, Ayres, and Gavin meant that Paul Hughes was able to declare the innings closed at 5/304."

Western Park’s bowlers were very disciplined with Paul Hughes setting the examples for others to follow. He bowled with good pace and accuracy to finish with 5/55 and Buln were bundled out for 129. The Warriors after having a good victory then had 1 ½ hours to gain some valuable batting practice, but wasted it being 6/70 at the close of play.

This woeful batting display all started with the rather sensational dismissal of opener Paul Gavin. As is often the way when a player is out of form, he finds new and unusual ways to get out. On this occasion ‘Gavo’ decided anything Gooch could do he could do too, as the balled rolled back towards his stumps he knocked it away, not with his bat, not with his foot, but with his hand...*you idiot!*”

From the Gazette (by 'The Roving Warrior'): “Western Park played host to the Nilma-Darnum Dusties in Round 6 of the WDCA. Paul Hughes won the toss and elected to bowl in cool and conditions, which made play awkward for all concerned. Western Park’s bowlers got off to a good start, grabbing the initiative with a wicket to Hughes in the seventh over when he had Gould caught at the wicket for four. At the other end Roberts seemed to be struggling with the conditions but still managed to pick up the important wicket of McFarlane for 20. With the score at 2/50 and NDD in recovery mode, Hughes struck again – bowling Brewster – [and] he then made the bowling change that would enable the Warriors to get right on top of their opponents.

From the moment Jason Hodder took the ball he made life difficult for the batsmen. Moving the ball in the air and off the deck, picking up the wickets of Horsford and the Barnes’ soon after to finish with the miserly figures of 3/9 in a wonderful 15-over spell. The wickets fell at a steady rate with McLean keeping the pressure on from the other end with some intelligent bowling and the combine were all out for 88 with an hour and half’s play remaining – Hughes, Hodder, and McLean finishing with three wickets each. The Warriors started poorly in their chase being 1/8 when Paul Gavin’s run of outs continued, and then 2/13 when Litaize thrust his pad at one outside off only to be caught behind for three, finally recovering to be 2/39 at the close.”

From the Gazette: “Day Two saw rain clouds looking with Western Park 49 runs in arrears. Their intentions were made clear to all when Ayres swatted the first ball of the day straight back over the bowlers’ head, and the race for first innings points was on. NDD were kept interested as the Warriors were prepared to sacrifice wickets to reach their target and were 6/95 when Hughes declared their innings close at 1.40pm with Pollard and Roberts being the major contributors with 23 runs apiece, and McCluskey bagging four wickets for NDD. When the visitors began their second dig and got off to a solid start adding 25 for the first wicket, no one would have expected what was to follow.

Batting one short, NDD were skittled for 64, with Peter Croft the destroyer. He had a nice breeze and exploited it to the tune of 6/12 off 12 overs. Although a few more six-wicket hauls will be required for ‘Crofty’ to win the Active Outdoor Sports Club Championship Award, with John Pollard the tearaway leader at this stage. The Warriors now had 18 overs in which to collect 58 runs for outright victory. But in a game in which ball had dominated bat so much so...this was no certainty. In fact, it took until Western Park until the 17th over.”

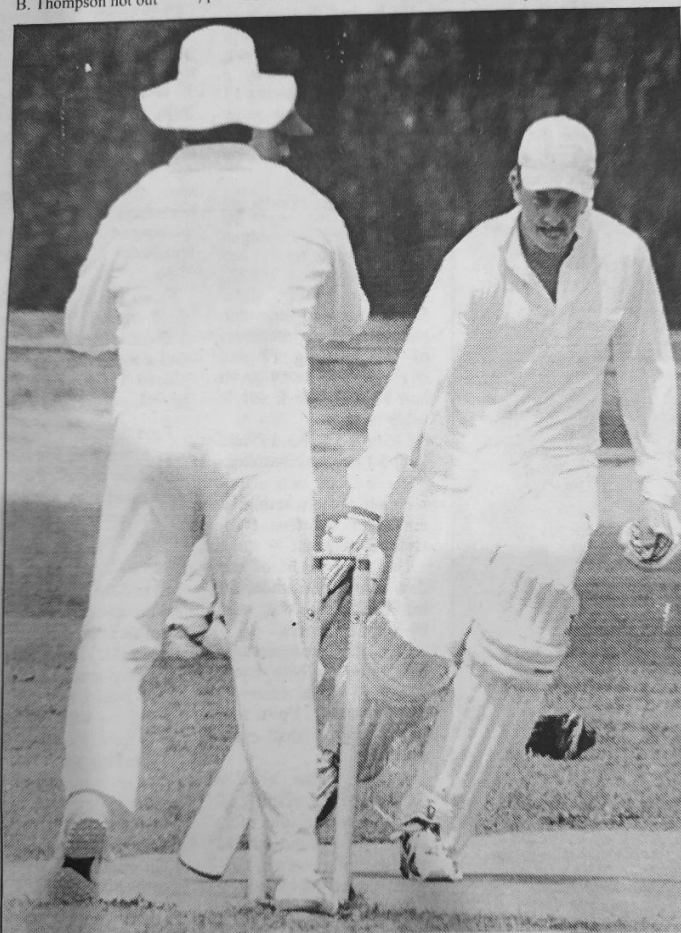

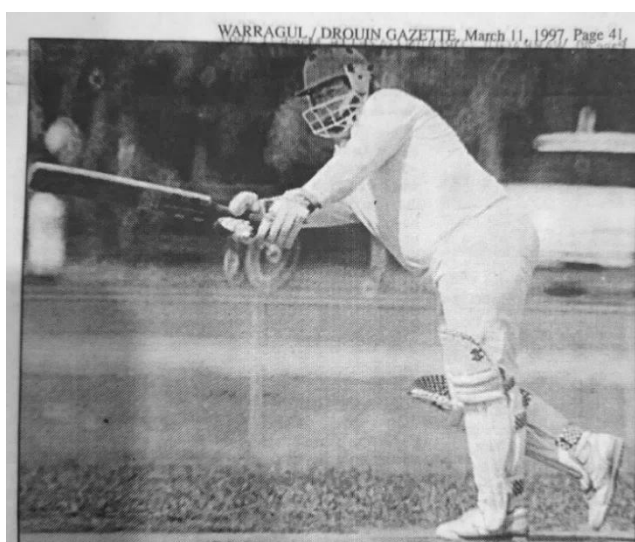

From the Gazette: “The Warriors were at home to Yarragon; Rod Breeden won the toss and batted. Breeden and Bailey opened the innings adding 22 before Bailey was out for 16, then Breeden went for eight with the score on 2/34 and when McPhail became Harvey’s second victim Western Park were on the skids at 3/36. A valuable 30-run partnership between Allison and Mick Hughes – of which ‘Chopper’ Hughes smashed 29 in quick time – got them back on track. Their joy was short-lived however, both being bowled in quick succession and the Warriors slumped to 5/68 before tea. Yarragon must have thought themselves a chance with two new batsmen at the crease. But these two – namely Norris and Kleeven – steadied the ship and then produced a partnership of 105 runs off 20 overs to take the score to 173, when ‘Hank’ got out for a hard-hitting 57. Cusden joined ‘Chuck’ and they added 39 before the latter was out for his highest score since joining the club, an excellent contribution of 59. 7/212 when ‘Cus’ was joined by the Warriors International Cricketer of the Year – John Laffy Wong – on tour from Singapore, who featured in two partnerships yielding 30 runs in total.

'Red' Kirkham continued his run spree collecting another 16, and Western Park finished with 252... Yarragon's run-chase started disastrously – Lindsay George out for 0 with the score on 1 – and then 2/19 when 'Wedgy' Pharaoh followed for five. A great knock of 75 runs from Asmussen got them back in the game, but a century was denied from him when Laffy Wong upset his woodwork. Yarragon must have been a chance, but batting two players short, weren't able to get up, finishing with 180 with solid contributions from Hanley (23), Regester (21), and Nick Mazza (25). The Warriors shared their wickets with Laffy Wong three and two apiece to Cusden and Hughes."

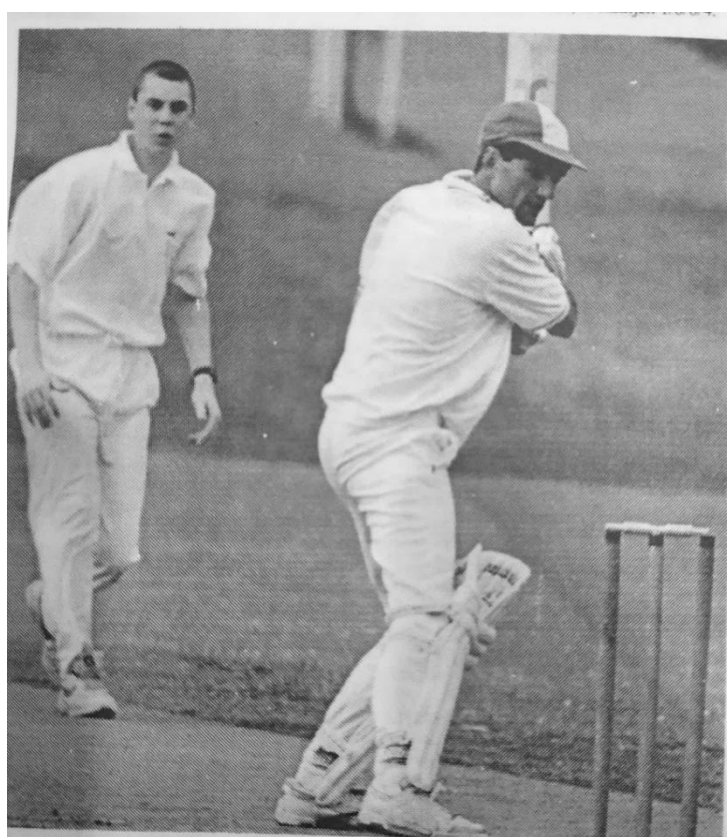

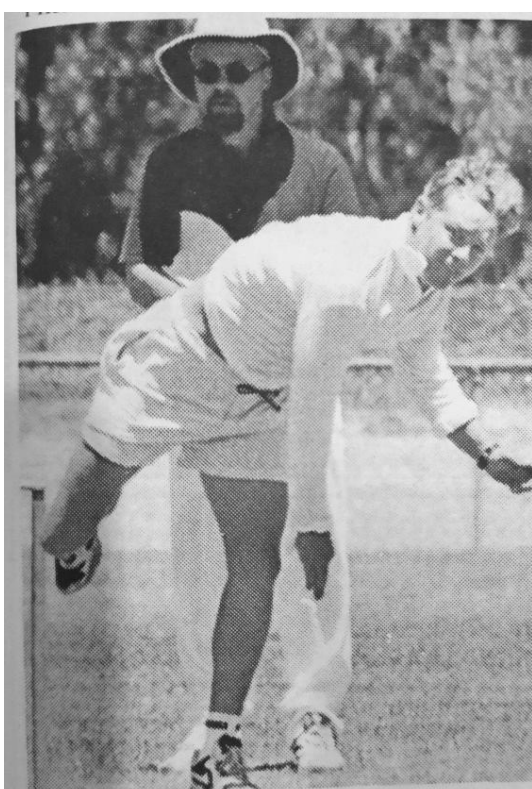

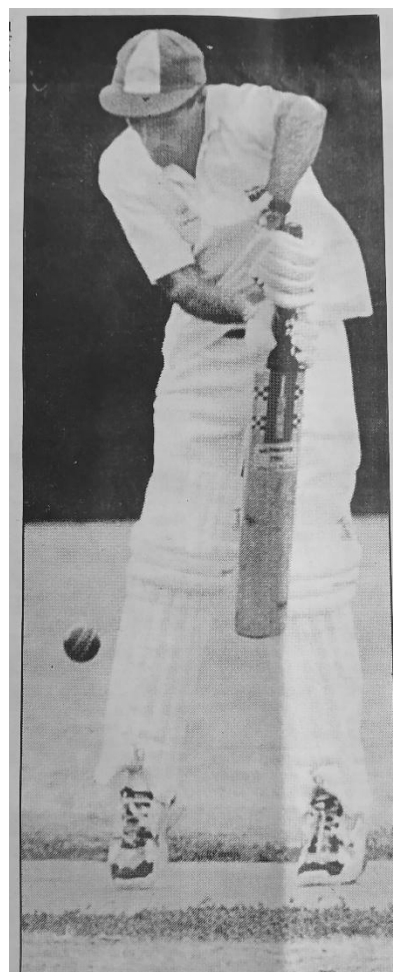

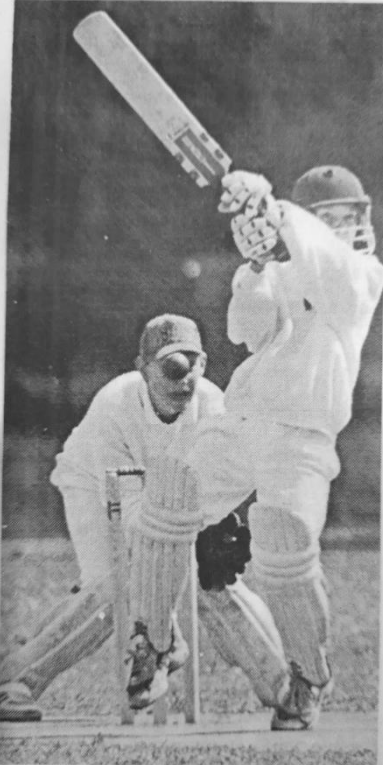
