Pre-Season Preview (by 'Bangladesh Yenrab')

"It's about that time yet again where the whites come out and retirements cease to exist as cricket season is about to commence, with the first competitive ball to be bowled on Saturday, October 3rd. As the headline stated the WDCA is running short of cricket areas this year as two more grounds have gone by the wayside in Tynong (apparently unplayable) and St. Paul's (dug up for a gym). If what has happened in previous years occurs again with Western Park's ground (not available until December) the estimated 18 games a week will have to be played on 17 ovals which simply doesn't fit. That's including using Neerim's ground and Longwarry's ground every week to accommodate a full round of cricket. However Western Park should be available from the start of the season this year... while St. Paul's are building another oval which will not be ready until next year.

Drouin: Will be a big threat again this year with key players being Ron Harper, Travis Davies, and coach Rick Minichiello. Paul Wyatt, Benny Wyatt, Derek Milner and co. will make them a fairly evenly balanced side that has seen them play in the past four Grand Finals.

Ellinbank: Geoff Van Vugt will coach Ellinbank this year, his decision to stay sees Ellinbank with the chance of going one step further than they did last year in A-Grade. Peter Wallace, George Masterson, Brad Aitken, Harry Anderson, Matt Sharman, and Rick Gray will see them be a force again.

Warragul: Warragul has re-appointed last year's captain-coach Ben Ryan, but the loss of Darren Gahan (Geelong), brothers Ray (bowls) and Adie (Bairnsdale) Waters could leave them a couple of experienced players short and with the reported rumours of the possible departure of Leigh Baldry, could also see young Bob stop playing as well. Junior depth is very good indeed, but they may lack the A-Grade experience required to be a threat this year, but time will tell.

Western Park: A-Grade premiers Western Park has tried to keep all of last year's premiership players. Paul Hughes, Simon Byrne, John Pollard, Chris Ayres, Paul Gavin, Shaun Litaize, Peter Croft, Bryan McLean, Matt Wakefield, Paul McCluskey, and Man of the Match Mick Roberts are all staying on and will start favourites for this year's flag as they so rightly deserve.

Neerim District: [Have] been very quiet again, but the return of Danny Sheehan will assist them in becoming a finalist once again. They have been putting their bowling machine to regular use. Steve Clarke might have played his last game, but time will tell. Greg Fusinato, Dale Fawcett, Brett Thompson, Richie Christian, Marc Pinkerton, and Adam Lennox will be their backbone yet again.

Yarragon: Will rely heavily on Paul George, Nick Mazza, Peter Mazza (who has returned), James Brown, Murphy and co. again. They must build on what they have got so that they can come from the outer which they have been in over the last couple of years. Their other stalwarts in Brendan Kingwill, John Malacarne, Ross Follett, and co. will be there doing battle once again.

Buln: [Have] appointed Dale Serong as coach with brother Jamie Serong assisting him. Brian Sell has saddled up for another year while Ken Pratt and Nev Fawcett look like going out to pasture, time will tell. Brent Eastwell is going to Dandenong. Jeremy Jagoe, Chris Hinsley, and Andrew Ferguson are back while the Pask brothers Grant (returning) and Glenn [are] joining as well.

Hallora: Have the three McMahon boys – David, James and Tim – Ryan Flack, Col Parnall, Stuart McDonald, and Simon and Mark Phillips. I'm sure they will be hard to toss again, and I know they have looked at some coaching personnel. Possible recruits look like coming from Lang Lang so I hear, but we will have to wait and see.

Other Teams: Nilma-Darnum Dusties have unfortunately withdrawn from A-Grade...Longwarry have yet to decide how many senior teams to enter while Bunyip have gone B and D instead of B and C. Garfield have gone B and C while Iona will again enter two sides, while Jindivick is still deciding whether to enter three senior sides, one in B and two in C."

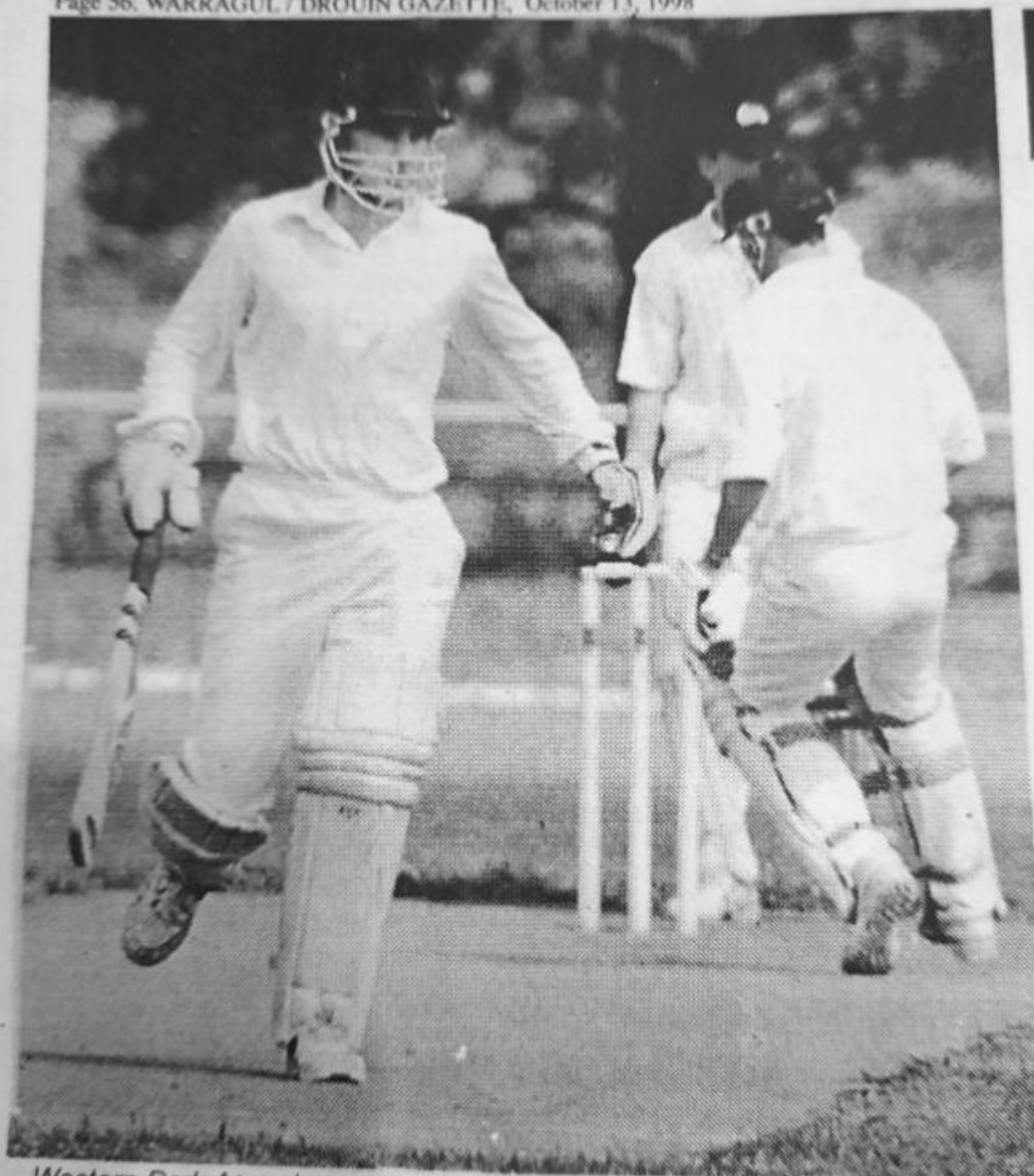

From the Gazette (by Jim Marsh): “Warragul A-Grade followed up their Round 1 win with another on Saturday...Western Park won the toss and elected to bat and with strike bowler Anthony Wilkes unavailable due to work commitments the other bowlers had to lift if Warragul was to get early wickets. Mark Hiriati and young Xavier Gargan opened the bowling and after bowling a very tight spell Hiriati struck in his fourth over after conceding only four runs.

Gargan then picked up the two very important wickets of McCluskey and Litaize and Western Park were 3/50. Wickets continued to fall and at one stage Hiriati was on a hat-trick in his last over. ‘Bumpy’ Runnalls picked up the last two Western Park wickets to leave them with a score of 9/125. Hiriati was the pick of the bowlers with a great spell of 3/23...Bob Baldry and Steve Tweddle opened the innings for Warragul and got off to a very good start with Tweddle going in the 19th over for a well-made 38 Baldry and last-game century-maker Ben Ryan continued to pick up the runs and Warragul was well on the way to victory when Baldry went for 34. With all batsmen getting a start and batting well, Ryan was out for 35 and the game was already won.”

From the Gazette (by 'The Macktank'): "A sterling century by Grant Williams has seen Hallora A-Grade register the good score of 237 against last season's premiers Western Park. It was a classy ton by Williams, a full range of shots played keeping the large crowd entertained. On what would easily be described as a balmy Saturday afternoon, Hallora captain Simon Phillips won the toss and elected to bat, the Parkers all too keen to take the field. Openers Mark Phillips and Craig Russell started the innings cautiously with Paul Hughes and Mick Roberts bowling a treat. With the score on 18, 'W.G. Russell' tried to whip a leg glance off Hughes but unfortunately was trapped LBW for six. Grant Williams then joined Phillips at the crease and the pair knuckled down to form a good partnership of 24 – Mark especially ruthless on any loose balls.

Mick Roberts however continued his tight spell and in the 16th over a lifting delivery found Philips' edge, McCluskey taking the straightforward catch. Phillips out for 22, Hallora: 2/42. James McMahon then took the crease and with the Parkers taking ascendancy, Hallora needed a steadying partnership. Roberts, Hughes, and McLean continued to apply the pressure with some accurate line and length bowling giving very little to the Hallora batsmen. After a dogged 38-run partnership, a great catch at bat-pad by Shaun Litaize off the bowling of Hughes saw McMahon dismissed for a slow 12, Hallora: 3/80.

In what was one of the better partnerships made at the Hallora Rec. (barring Yarragon's John Allsop and Nathan Bright's last wicket stand of 201 last season), Colin Parnall and Williams consolidated the Hallora innings and established a 111-run fourth-wicket partnership at three an over. Both batsmen found good touch in the middle choosing the right balls to hit more often than not. Williams was especially brutal on any loose bowling, a sweep shot off Croft an absolute pearler. A real asset to the Parkers was newcomer Brendan Davies whose excellent swing bowling hindered Hallora's progress. He will definitely be a trump card for the Parkers this year. After a wonderful partnership a rank full toss in the dark by Paul Hughes shattered Parnall's stumps. Colin departing for a well-deserved and patient 41, Hallora: 4/191.

Hallora lost another wicket shortly afterwards when Ryan Flack swished at a couple before Hughes slid one through him. Flack out for 0, Hallora: 5/191. At the other end, Williams continued to chalk up the runs and after surviving a fumbled catch on 88 – and receiving good support by speedy partner Marty Gray – Williams proceeded to finish the job and recorded his first hundred for the club to the standing ovation of the Hallora Community Gallery. Not long after a tragic mix-up saw Williams run out for 108, his highest ever score. Hallora: 6/203 with eight overs to go.

Dave McMahon and Marty Gray tried pushing up the run-rate, David bowled by Hughes for four swinging hard. Hallora: 7/211. Simon Phillips then teamed with Gray, and the pair worked hard to keep the score ticking over against another top spell of bowling by Roberts and Hughes. Phillips struck out with some big cover drives and Gray chipped in with some sensible shot making. A skied ball on the last ball of the day saw Phillips out for 13, leaving Gray 17 not out and Hallora 8/237. Best of the bowlers was Paul Hughes who consistently found a good length and troubled most batsmen. Hughes' 5/52 off 24 overs was certainly a superb effort and a good result for the hard toil he put in all day. Mick Roberts' hearty pre-season training saw him in fine form, his two lengthy spells being of high quality."

From the Gazette (by 'The Freak'): "Hallora has now produced one of its most productive few weeks of a season when it defeated Western Park comfortably on the weekend by 82 runs in a game of high standard cricket played in excellent spirits. The day started with the Parkers chasing the 237 set last week and Hallora knew they had to bowl Western Park out to win the game. Simon Phillips and Michael Kirkham opened the bowling for the Kangas with both of them putting pressure on the opening bats in Litaize and McCluskey. It wasn't long before Phillips found the edge of Litaize, and he was caught to a great catch at third slip by Youlden for three. This brought Matt Wakefield to the crease and with the bowlers in Kirkham, Phillips, and Youlden bowling well, scoring was difficult.

An airborne square drive by Wakefield found the evergreen hands of Craig Russell at point and he departed cheaply off the bowling of Youlden. McCluskey was next to depart, driving at another Youlden delivery only to be caught at slip by Kirkham. His stay in the pavilion was short-lived however, when he was called upon to be a runner for Murray who was trying to lift the scoring rate with a few attempted lusty blows. In what was to prove a match-winning bowling change, James McMahon entered the fray for the first time this year. McMahon relished his opportunity and his very first delivery saw Ayres spoon a pull shot straight back to him, caught and bowled McMahon for seven.

Murray succumbed to an inswinging McMahon yorker which took out leg stump to have the Parkers 5/45. Simon Phillips re-entered the attack and bowled with god pace and accuracy. An edge off Davies' bat when attempting a hook shot resulting in a nasty cut opening on his chin. He battled on though and played some nice shots before a lightning catch in gully by Russell as Gavin depart for five, and Brendan Davies went shortly after for 17, the Parkers reeling at 7/84. McLean in particular was ruthless on any loose deliveries – at one stage lifting Youlden to the boundary twice in one over and once out of the ground – the ball landing on Main South Road to have 19 runs taken off Youlden's ultimate over.

They went into the tea break seven down with Hallora looking to close the match quickly. At this stage McMahon was bowling wonderfully, having taken 4/9 off five overs. McLean and Croft consolidated after tea to form Western Park's only good partnership for the day. These two batted for 18 overs with McLean making a good 52 that kept Western Park within a sniff of victory. McMahon slipped one through his defences to remove middle stump, and subsequently Western Park's best chance of victory, leaving them 8/145. Croft followed soon after for 30, bowled middle stump and off by Simon Phillips. James McMahon then picked up his sixth wicket, a just reward for his day's effort and excellent bowling performance. Western Park finished with 165."

From the Gazette: “Western Park won the toss against Buln on the first week of their match, in which it proved to be a good decision. Buln lost two early wickets, with the score only crawling to the twenties. Dale Serong came in for a quick 18, before three more quick wickets fell, to see Buln in early trouble at 5/50. Matt Nelson and Brent Lewien helped Buln to 5/80 at tea, but Western Park still had the upper hand. The next wicket fell at 6/91, where Brent lost his wicket for 28. Greg Walsh then joined Matt at the crease to see Buln to 7/113, when Greg lost his way for 13. After this Buln collapsed to be all out for a disappointing 134, with Matt Nelson remaining on 30 not out. Peter Croft was the best of the bowlers with 3/26, Paul Hughes also bowled well for 3/35, Mick Roberts 2/37, and Bryan McLean with 2/8 also bowled well. In reply, Western Park was 0/4 at stumps. At the resumption of the second day’s play, rain thwarted the start of play until 3.30, where Western Park started hesitantly for the first 10 overs or so.

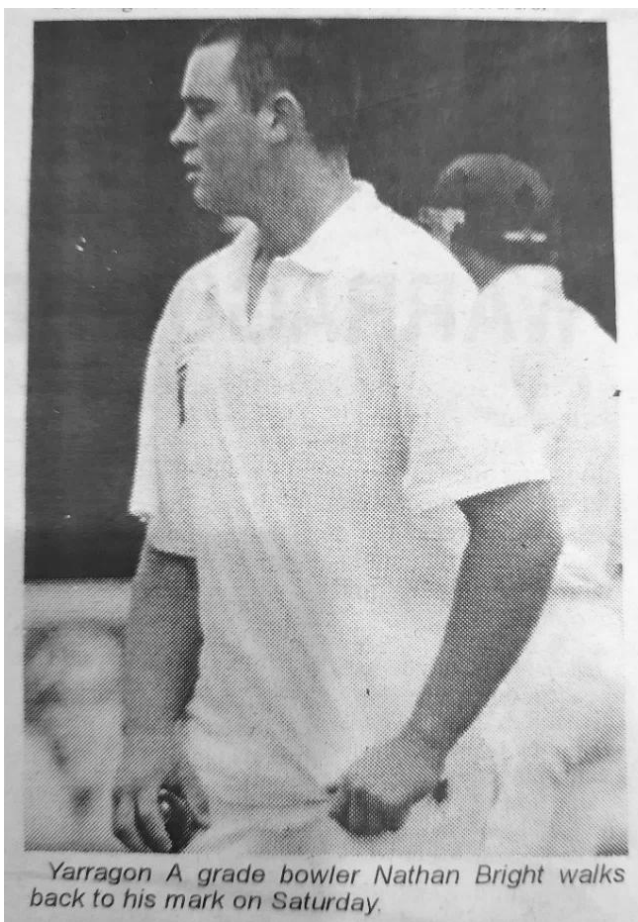
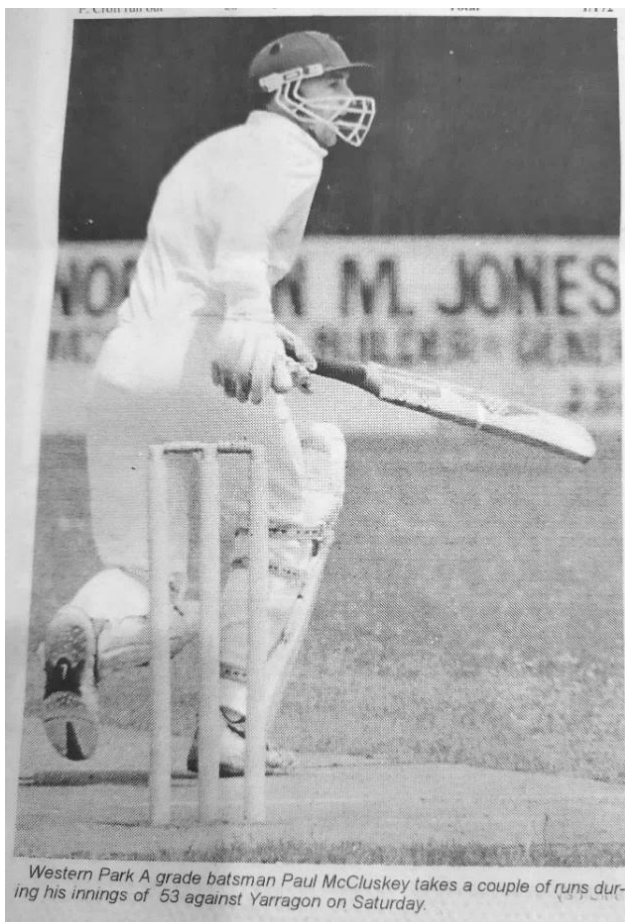
