Pre-Season League News

- The WDCA has entered into a two-year agreement with County for exclusive rights to use their cricket balls. All WDCA clubs have been sent details of the agreement and will be informed as news comes to hand.
- One-Day matches in B and C-Grade this season will be of 40 overs duration (as with A-Grade). Playing times will be 12.30pm to 5.30pm (but as all cricketers know, the games never finish on time). Two-Day games will remain as is with a 1pm start.

1997-98 Pre-Season Preview (by 'Bangladesh Yenrab')

It's that time of year again where cricket season is just around the corner with the first competitive ball to be bowled on Saturday October 4th. Administratively, Peter Heywood returns for his third term as President, while his right-hand men will yet again be Brian Sell and Ron Harper, these two have sat beside young 'Boots' since his first [stint] as 'Pres.' New Secretary is Paul Wyatt, whose enthusiasm has been evident in the WDCA's contract agreement for balls through County. Peter Gallasch returns as Score Recorder with new Treasurer being Rod Drake who has forfeited all voting rights after taking on the position from his wife Gail. Wet Weather Committee positions have been taken by Peter Heywood to the west, Mark Braddick to the north, with Ross Follett taking the third spot which is to the east of the outer areas of the WDCA.

Drouin: First news is that Ron Harper was invited to represent Gippsland in a pre-season match last Sunday, and if you didn't already know Ron also stood down as coach of Drouin earlier this year, but don't panic he is staying loyal to Drouin...he felt like it was time for a rest from the hustle and bustle and what a replacement Drouin have secured. Another bloke that just loves to menace us poor innocent batsmen is Rick Minichiello who returns from ex-WDCA side Trafalgar where he spent the last couple of years after a coaching stint at Western Park. Drouin certainly will be a big threat again this year with key players in Ron Harper, Travis Davies, and big 'Minna' being their trumps cards.

Ellinbank: Other coaching news sees that Geoff Van Vugt has accepted Ellinbank's coaching offer after not playing last season. His decision sees Ellinbank with a chance of returning as a potential A-Grade force again and my spies tell me that they will have a new top on their wicket. With players like Peter Wallace, Harry Anderson, Rick Gray, Matt Sharman, 'George' Masterson, and the rumoured return of Brad Aitken I'm sure they will be a tough combination to roll this year.

Warragul: Warragul have reappointed last year's premiership captain and last year's batting sensation Ben Ryan, who also won the Cricketer of the Year. Unfortunately for him – but fortunately for the club – Bob Baldry took the batting average off him after Bob's courageous innings in the Grand Final. These two will again be the key to their batting again this year along with Adie Waters and Darren Gahan. Hiriati and Wilkes will be their bowling backbone yet again and if all the rumours are true some of last year's premiership players could be missing with one being Ray Waters.

Western Park: Western Park have reappointed the very popular – and much sought-after figure in the WDCA – Paul Hughes. His decision to stay has been driven by his passion for that elusive A-Grade premiership at Western Park, something that has eluded them for the past few years after making the play-offs. Their key players will be yet again Hughes, Paul Gavin, Bryan McLean, Shaun Litaize, John Pollard, Chris Ayres, Peter Croft, and Mick Roberts and I'm sure they will be up there knocking on the door yet again. Only loss looks like being last year's secretary Jason Hodder.

Neerim District: The other finalist from last year Neerim District have been very quiet over the winter months. They have acquired a bowling machine which I'm sure Bob Southgate has been putting to regular use with the boys, which could mean that they might be the in-form batting side at the start of the year...Steve Clarke has returned from Queensland, and I know the boys are keen to atone for last year's dismal showing in the Semi-Final.

Dale Fawcett, Brett Thompson, Richie Christian, Matt Cumming, and Adam Lennox are their future stars, and with guidance from Greg Fusinato and Steve Clarke the District boys will have to remain on the ball again to make finals. Danny Sheehan looks to be their only loss with him reputedly going to [the] Northern Territory.

Yarragon: Yarragon have reappointed Lindsay George but were unable to obtain the services of Van Vugt as his assistant. Yarragon – who were middle of the road last year after a great start – have got some good youngsters in Jamie Brown and co. to build on after being in the outer for the last couple of years. They will rely heavily on Paul George, Nick Mazza, and Tony Kleeven for success this year yet again. If they have recruited some players to assist, then along with their other stalwarts in Brendan Kingwill, John Malacarne, Ross Follett and co., they will be a handful as they proved last year when they just missed the finals...their only loss looks to be Leigh Sheehan whose football commitments and study could leave him burnt out.

Buln: Buln have appointed Brian Sell as coach after Jamie Serong didn't seek re-election due to work and family commitments, but to Buln's joy Jamie and brother Dale are staying on in a lesser role in the club...Buln also tried to secure the services of Geoff Van Vugt and Paul Hughes but were unable to convince either of them to stay or come. They appear that they will stick with their youth policy, which saw Brent Eastwell, Corey Jagoe, Chris Hinsley, Paul Pratt, and Neil Olsson perform very well last year and have picked up Mark Serong, 'Nudge' Kenny...and have some other youngsters in...Anthony Thomas, Grant Aitken, and Hadyn Major waiting in the wings. Buln will rely heavily on the Serong Bros, Brent Eastwell, and Dave Fusinato with their coach Brian Sell still in some doubt because of injury. Grant Pask has left the district and will be sadly missed. A new slab and pitch will run virtually goal to goals, and it is hoped that they will be ready for the first week of cricket.

Hallora: Hallora finished last year off like a house on fire with some very good victories over Buln, Garfield, Western Park and Ellinbank. Not much news has filtered out from the little countryside area and as they proved last year under the guidance of Jeff Phillips, they can match it with anyone in the association. 'Spider' I'm told will not take the reins again and have lost the services of 'Nudge' Kenny to Buln, but with the talent they've got in the three McMahon boys, Brent Mounsey, Ryan Flack, Col Parnall, Stuart McDonald, and Simon and Mark Phillips I'm sure they will be hard to toss again.

Nilma-Darnum Dusties: NDD look like they've lost last year's coach Paul McCluskey back to either the Valley or Western Park...they also appear to have lost the services of Simon Barnes...Things should be easier in the second year together of the NDD, and after winning the B-Grade flag I'm sure they will have a few more players coming through to help them out. Most likely Andrew Runnalls will take charge again if they can't retain the services of McCluskey. Runnalls, Andy Fennell, Darren McFarlane, Steve Ward, Hayden Draper, and 'Punky' Brewster will still be their backbone again this year.

Garfield: The news from Garfield is that they have unfortunately had to ask the WDCA to leave them out of A-Grade after their attempts to recruit coaches and players fell through after trying since May this year. Garfield's attempts to recruit a coach was not from lack of effort or funds, but they kept hitting a brick wall through people's lack of commitment or uncertainty of employment...Mark Cousin will take on the role again as their 'minder' and along with Peter Heywood will be trying to rebuild themselves into A-Grade force yet again. Their losses include left-arm opening bowler Simon Phillipson to Sale, Mick Preston to Queensland, Joe Allen to football commitments, Matt Cunningham to possibly Darwin, with Bernard Marson and Rohan Beard still undecided with Marson's availability dictated by his college.

Other Sides: Departures of Gerard Mowat, Steve White, and Mark Serong from Longwarry will unfortunately result in them submitting one – not two – senior teams this year. That side being C-Grade, although they will field U-14 and U-12 teams this year. Iona will be putting in two C-Grade sides in their second year in the competition while Jindivick and Bunyip will be fielding sides in B and C-Grade again this year.

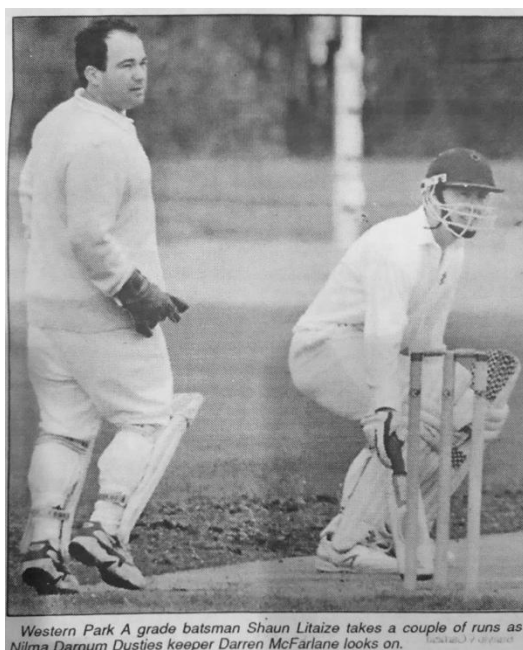

From the Gazette: “Reigning WDCA A-Grade premiers Warragul took on close rival Western Park in the second round of the 1997-98 season on Saturday. Western Park won the toss... and got off to a lucky start when the dangerous Litaize was dropped in the slips on the first ball of the match. Andrew Best made the breakthrough getting an LBW decision with the score on 1/28. Things weren’t looking too good for Warragul as the next pair put on 130 runs before Des Gahan got the all-important wicket... Andrew Best in his second spell claimed two wickets in a row... and Western Park finished on 5/182 after 40 overs. The run chase began well with James Young and Bob Baldry putting on 73 for the first wicket before ‘Youngy’ was out in the 18th over for a well-made 37. Ben Ryan joined Bob at the crease and the two put on a further 43 when Baldry was out to a good catch after making 50. Warragul then lost 3/31 but Des Gahan steadying the ship with 27 late in the innings, and it was left to Graeme Hiriati and ‘Wilko’ to take Warragul over the line.”

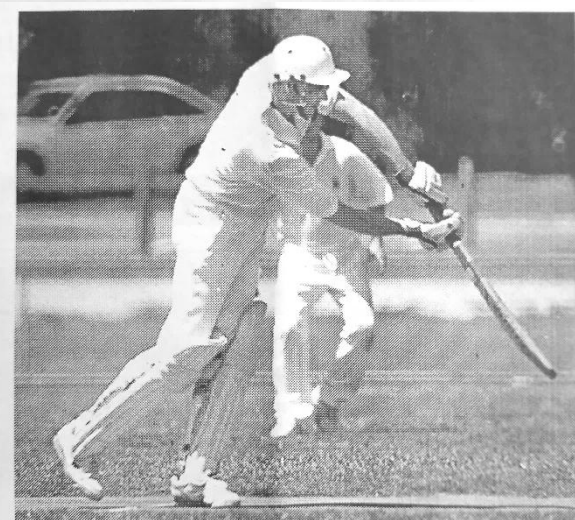
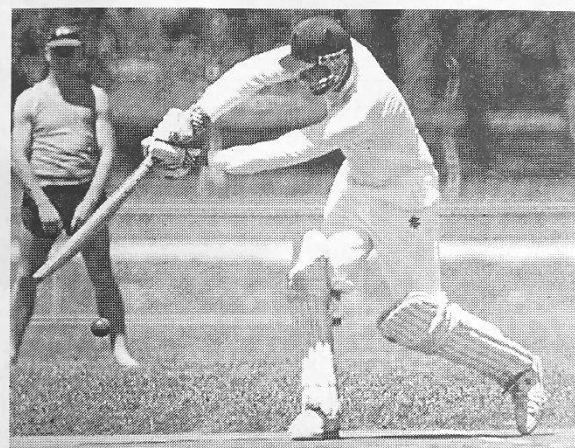
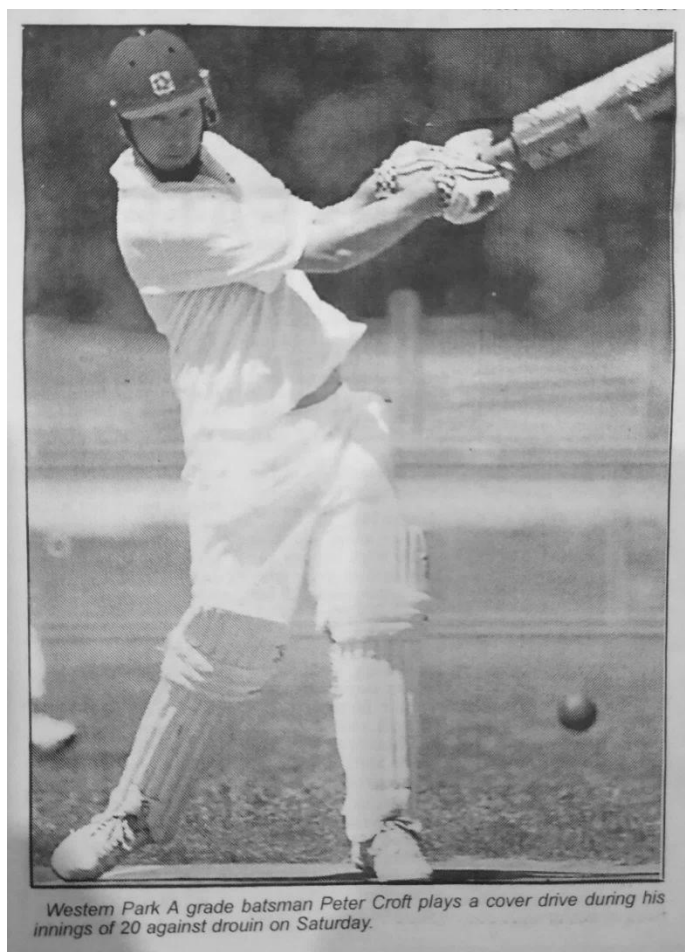

With the Parkers being a top-quality bowling side, Ron's innings was a true test of his temperament playing defensively, pushing the ball around, and smashing the bad or short one to the fence. Drouin after 70 overs were 5/147 when Ron and Liam let go, belting everything they could in the last 10 over, getting Drouin up to a good score of 232. Ron's innings came to an end at the end of play, finishing on 98 not out – probably one of the best innings a lot of cricketers and spectators have seen. After seven overs three top-order batsmen were out to great catches from Paul Wyatt, Liam 'The Cat' Keating, and Derek Milner, and strong tight bowling from Minichiello and Davies. The partnership between Gavin and Ayres was looking threatening when two more quality catches were taken from B. J. and Benny Wyatt – not to mention good bowling from Nottage and Neumann leaving the Parkers struggling on 5/72.

Wickets continued to fall after tea with 'Joxy' Perry bowling very tight and with Steven (K. B.) Nottage taking screamers in the pocket, Western Park were finally bowled out for 147. 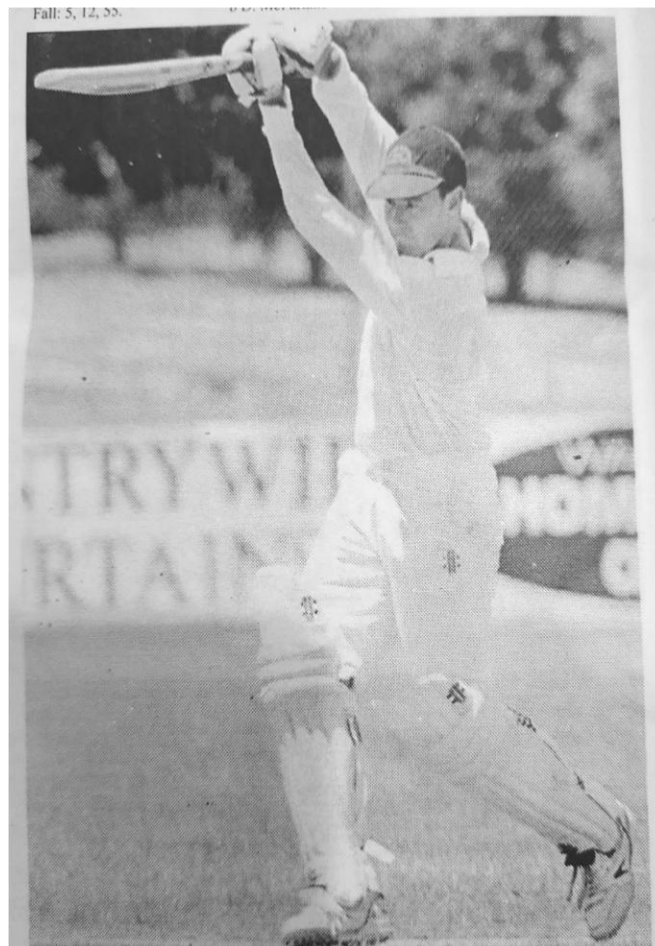

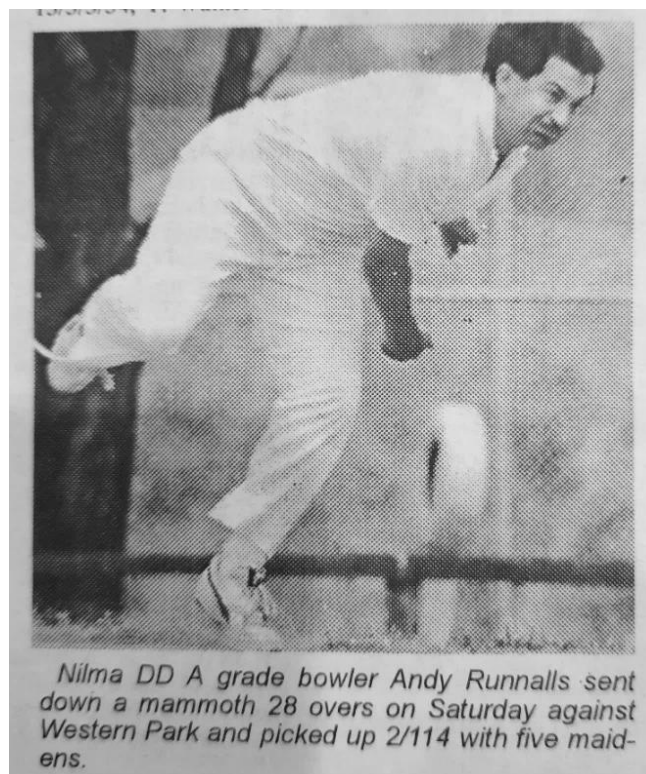
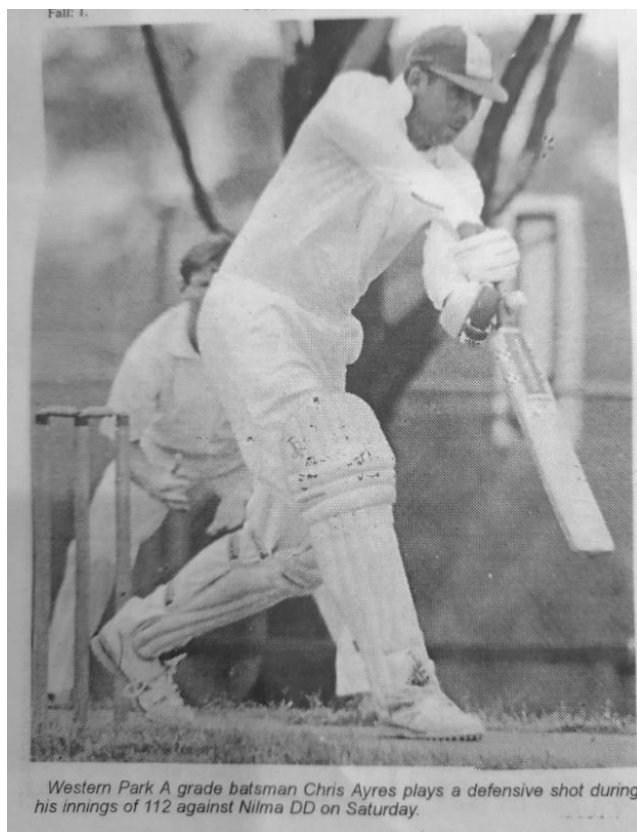

Western Park Breaks 29-Year Drought – *From the Gazette (by ‘Thor’)*: “When St. Andrews CC defeated Drouin to win the 1968-69 WDCA A-Grade Grand Final, very few people would have believed the club was about to endure a 29-year A-Grade premiership drought. That drought was broken when Western Park CC – as it is now known – was victorious against the previously undefeated Drouin CC. Drouin won the toss and elected to bat but got off to a nervous start against the Western Park quicks. The Park was then dealt a cruel blow when it lost fast bowler Simon Byrne to a shoulder injury in the early overs. Drouin’s opening pair of Derek Milner and Paul Wyatt settled in with Milner growing in confidence. Mick Roberts was brought into the attack to replace Byrne and enjoyed immediate success having Milner caught behind by Paul McCluskey with the score on 28.

Dave Anderson joined Wyatt at the crease and these two worked hard against some good bowling from Roberts and Paul Hughes, but with the score 1/50 the rain came, and play was interrupted for 30 minutes. Drouin resumed in a comfortable position and the wet and greasy conditions should have hampered the bowlers. Roberts however had other ideas, removing Wyatt – caught by Bryan McLean at second slip – for seven. Ron Harper now joined Anderson, taking Drouin to 67, then Harper attempted to hit Roberts to the leg side, only managing to drag the ball onto his stumps.

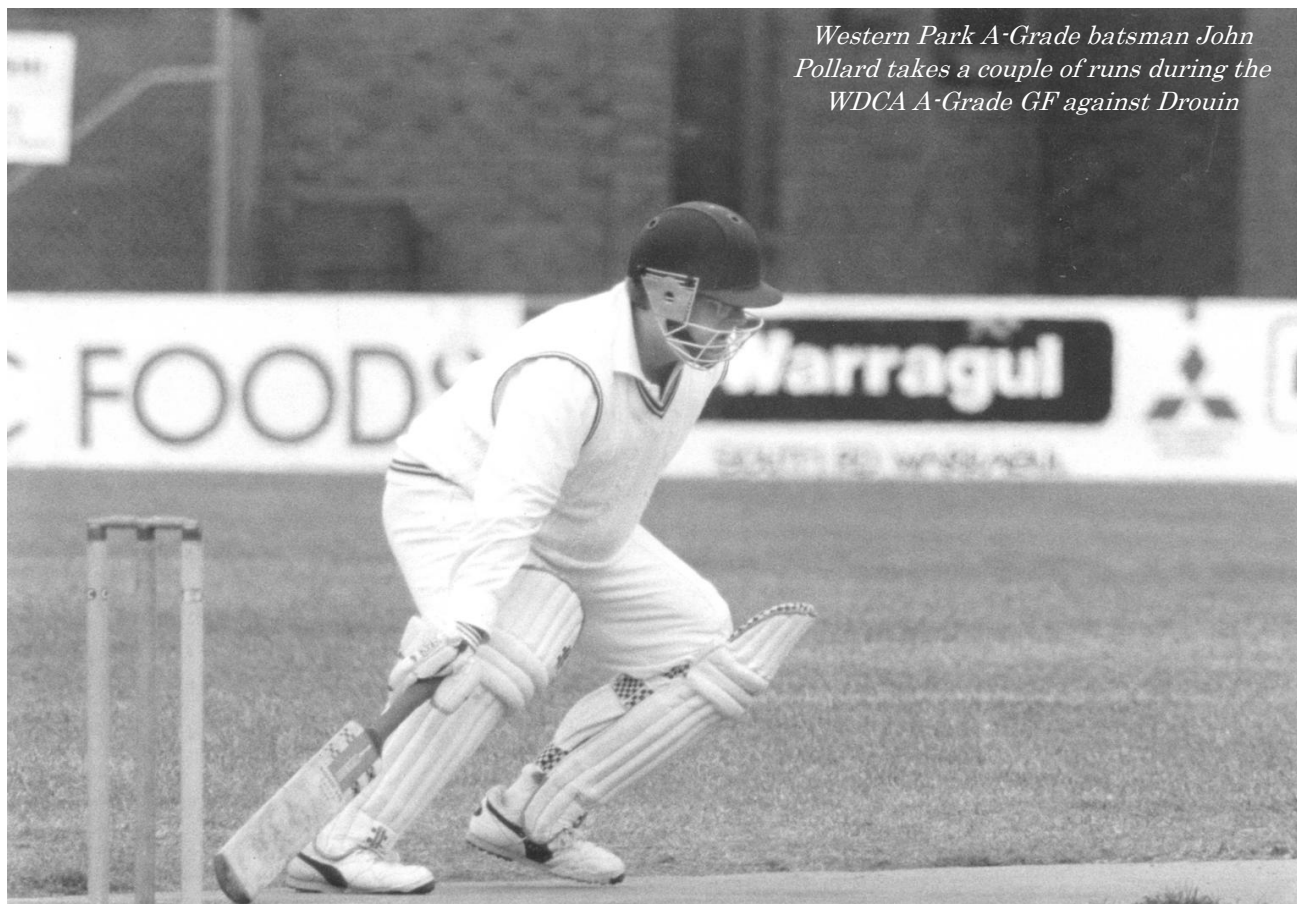
This was a great blow struck by Western Park but at 3/67 there was still a lot of work to be done, with the dangerous Travis Davies coming to join Anderson who was hanging in for Drouin and having his share of luck. Paul Hughes was using all his experience trying to dislodge these two batsmen, concentrating his attack around the wicket to the right-handed Anderson. But it wasn't until he tried the same tactic with the left-handed Davies that he got the breakthrough, with Travis edging one to Chris Ayres at slip. Drouin was now 4/79 and shortly afterwards 5/83 when Hughes got the important wicket of Anderson – caught behind by Paul Gavin – for a fighting 29. The Hawks were now desperate for a partnership but with the score on 90 Western Park took a stranglehold on the final when in the space of 14 deliveries it took 4/4. Roberts had Neumann and Steve Austen trapped in front LBW and then he bowled Liam Keating. Hughes got the Drouin skipper Rick Minichiello with a nasty ball which took off from a good length, caught the shoulder of his bat, and ballooned to Peter Croft in gully. Phil Wyatt together with Jon Perry took the score from 9/93 to 116 before Roberts brought the innings to a close – when he bowled Wyatt – giving him 7/46 and the Man of the Match award. Paul Hughes bowled 28 overs on the trot, maintaining relentless pressure to end with 3/47.

Day Two started with Western Park on 0/4 and requiring a further 113 runs to win. Drouin had a good reputation for defending low scores, but the big question was, did they have enough time? Normally Western Park would have knocked these runs up with not much problem, but the pressure is always there in a final. Shaun Litaize and Paul McCluskey opened up with Minichiello throwing everything at them, bowling with plenty of pace and fire. Travis Davies bowled honestly and lent good support. Minichiello struck first snaring the valuable wicket of Litaize – caught behind by Phil Wyatt for 16 – with the score on 26. McCluskey followed soon afterwards for five when Davies had him caught at mid-wicket where he spooned a catch to Keating.

With the score 2/28 and the Drouin boys with their tails up, Paul Gavin joined John Pollard and together they steadied the ship, working together to pick off the required runs. Just when Western Park looked like getting on top, Minichiello had Pollard caught at slip for 16 and they stumbled to be 3/56. Chris Ayres joined Gavin and Drouin had swung Perry into the attack, hoping to force an error from the Western Park pair. They added 20 then the error came when Ayres tried to work a ball on-side but got a leading edge to be caught by Anderson off the bowling of Perry for 15. 4/75 then 5/79 when Perry had Simon Byrne smartly stumped by Wyatt, and Drouin now had a sniff. Bryan McLean came to the wicket with Gavin and immediately started playing his shots. This relieved the pressure, and these two saw Western Park to victory, McLean 30 n.o. and Gavin unbeaten on 19. Drouin's captain-coach Rick Minichiello bowled very well taking 2/56 off 22 unchanged overs. But this was to be Western Park's day, and after nine consecutive years in the finals with success, and 29 years in the wilderness, they became 1997-98 A-Grade premiers."



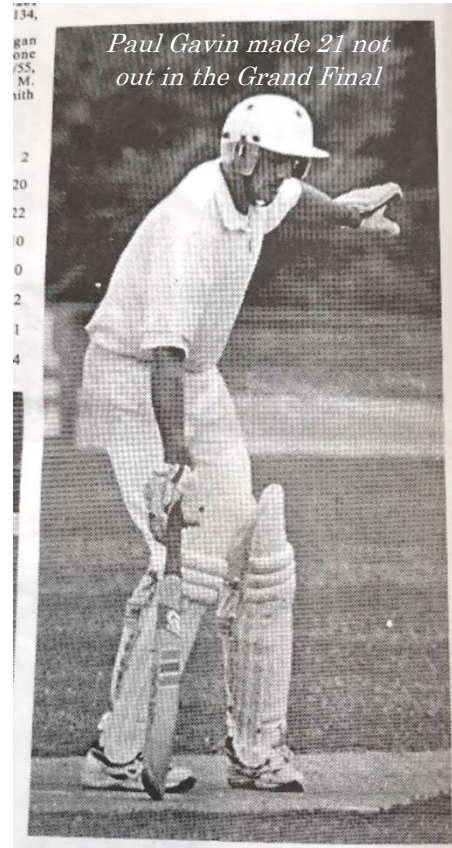

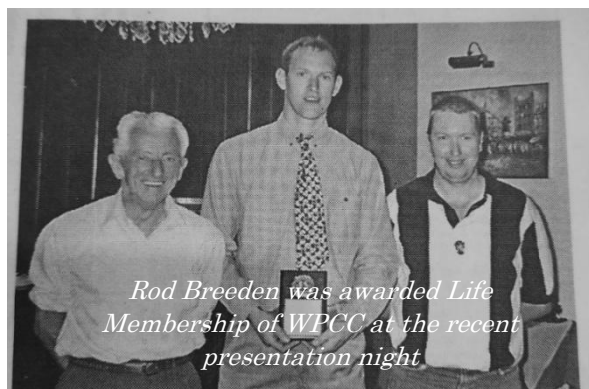

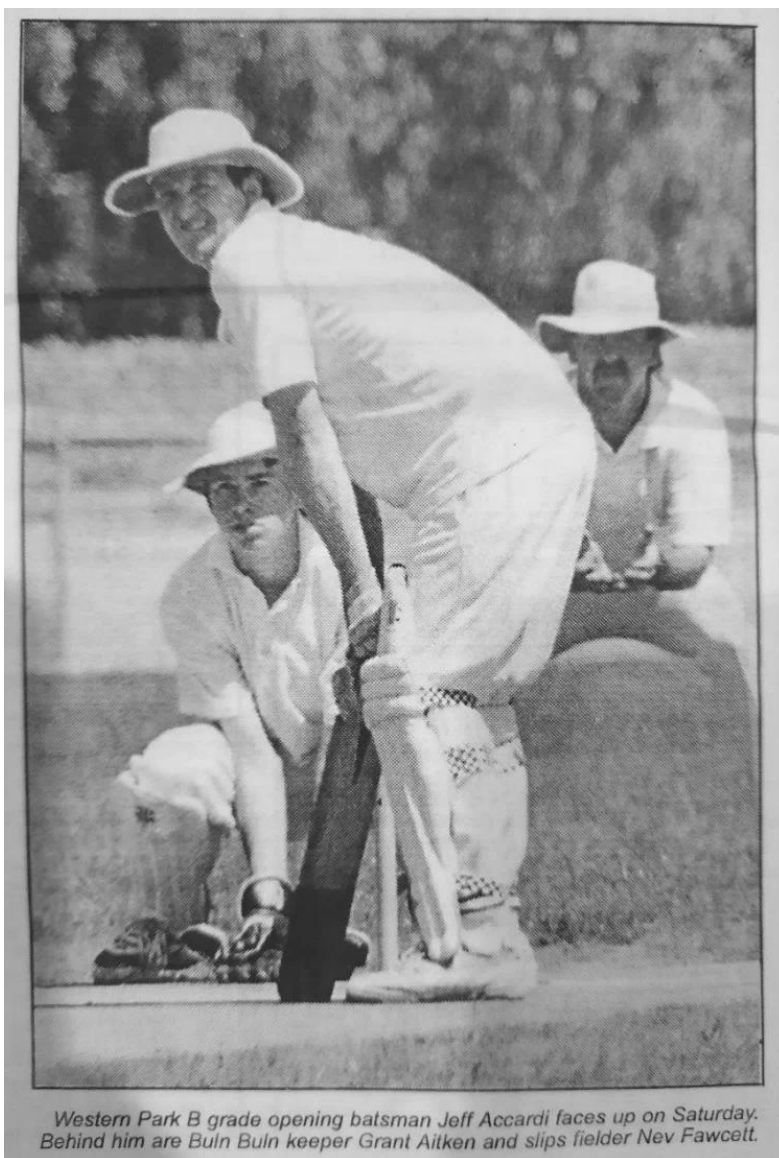
